SILVER CHARM SHARP AT SANTA

ANITA Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm (Silver Buck), who missed a few days of training after shipping to California from Churchill Downs and coming down with a slight fever, proved himself back on track with a solid work at Santa Anita vesterday morning. The grey zipped five furlongs in :59 3/5 as he prepares for his next start in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 3. "He worked great," said jockey Gary Stevens, who was aboard for the breeze. "He was blowing a bit. (Trainer Bob Baffert) really hasn't done a lot with him the last couple of weeks, so this was a pretty serious work. He handled it well, went great and his attitude was great-he enjoyed it." Added Baffert, "I had to stop on him, but he's fine now. He was pretty eager today. I caught him galloping out in 1:13 1/5. We'll set him down good in his next work." Stevens, himself recovering from knee surgery, is expected to ride at Hollywood Wednesday, "The knee feels good," he said. "(Friday) was my first day working horses-just one. I had some stiffness (Friday) night, and this morning it was a little stiff early on, but I felt great when I was riding."

"BUSINESS" AS USUAL Business is Boomin

(Businessisbusiness), an eight-year-old who returned to action after exactly five years off to win a \$15,000 claiming race at Garden State May 8, made it two-fortwo on the comeback trail with a dramatic win at Monmouth Park yesterday afternoon. Sent off at 2-1 in the \$23,000 turf allowance event, sixth race on the card, the chestnut sat fourth while in traffic to deep stretch, then found a seam to run through and just got up to best 8-5 favorite **Ray's Approval** (With Approval) by a nose. The Kentucky-bred, owned and trained by Michael Dickinson, was making his eighth career start Saturday; he has been first or second in all four turf tries.
