HAT TRICK FOR AGA KHAN The lightly-raced filly Ebadivla (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) stormed to victory in vesterday's G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks at The Curragh in Ireland, giving a third 1997 European Classic victory to her owner-breeder the Aga Khan. She follows in the footsteps of French 2000 Guineas winner Daylami and French Oaks heroine Vereva. The win also gave Ireland's champion jockey Johnny Murtagh, who captured the 1995 Breeders' Cup Mile aboard Ridgewood Pearl, his first classic success. In only her fourth lifetime start. Ebadivla produced an impressive turn of foot in the final quarter mile to overtake 6-4 favorite Yashmak (Danzig) and drew off to an easy three-length win. Yashmak, who had been unruly at the start, lost a shoe in the race and just held on for second from the French challenger Brilliance (Fr) (Priolo). Winning trainer John Oxx said, "I would think the (G1) Yorkshire Oaks (August 20) is the obvious target for her now, especially as the Aga Khan has the French oaks winner Vereva, who he will aim at the Prix Vermeille." Johnny Murtagh was thrilled: "Ebadiyla loves to see some daylight and once I got her clear on the inside a quarter mile out, she picked up brilliantly and went about her business. I'm so delighted she has won so well for Mr Oxx and her owner, who have given me so many good horses to ride." For complete Irish Oaks results, see p. 2

FREE HOUSE BOUND FOR SWAPS GI Santa Anita Derby winner Free House (Smokester) will start next in Hollywood Park's \$500,000 GII Swaps S. next Sunday. The grey colt, third in the Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. and second in the Preakness S., will miss a rematch with Triple Crown rivals Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) and Silver Charm (Silver Buck) who look likely to hook up again in the August 3 \$1,000,000 GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. "The plan would be to run here and then run in the (August 23) Travers (at Saratoga)," Free House's trainer Paco Gonzalez said from his Hollywood Park base. "The other race (Haskell) is too close. The horse is here, he's training well over this track and it makes more sense to stay." The threeyear-old is unraced since his third-place finish in the June 7 Belmont and Gonzalez is optimistic about his charge's chances in the nine-furlong Swaps. "He's doing really good. We couldn't ask for him to be doing any better. He loves the mile-and-an-eighth distance and I think he'll run well."

### WHO'S HOT SIRES OF THE KEENELAND SUMMER SALE by Jack Werk

Of the 259 yearlings being offered at the Keeneland July Yearling Sale, 13 stallions are represented by 10 or more yearlings. Those 13 stallions account for 62 percent of the entries (161 of 260) and 12 of the 13 are Northern Dancer-line (5) and Mr. Prospector-line (7) stallions.

While the impact of these two sirelines to the U.S. stallion population is well known, a closer look at the Keeneland catalog, where pedigree is a major criterion, indicates just how narrow the upper echelon of the stallion population is in terms of diversity of sirelines.

As the chart below shows, just four sirelines - Seattle Slew (1974), Mr. Prospector (1970), Roberto (1969), and Northern Dancer (1961) - account for 230 of the 260 yearlings, nearly 90 percent of the sale. What is surprising is the ages of these four stallions. We are not talking about Polynesian (1942), Nearco (1935), Nasrullah (1940) or Royal Charger (1942), the types of stallions you'd expect when quoting such a statistic.

Seattle Slew, the youngest of Keeneland's dominant four, has 15 yearlings in the sale and his sons A.P. Indy and Capote have seven each. Next comes Mr. Prospector with 14 yearlings himself plus nine sons and two grandsons with another 85 yearlings. Roberto is represented with 17 yearlings by three of his sons - Kris S. (9), Silver Hawk (4) and Red Ransom (4). Last but not least, Northern Dancer-line stallions, 17 in all, make up a third of the sale with 85 yearlings.

However, Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector alone account for more than 70 percent of the sale. This fact highlights the lack of diversity in the U.S. stallion population.

The U.S. stallion ranks are overdue for the re-introduction of foreign bloodlines, with South America and Australia possibly being the best candidates. The big question, of course, is whether or not the commercial market will embrace such a concept. Leading Kentucky farms recognize the need to add to the diversity of the stallion population and are aggressively taking steps to do so.

One sireline the commercial market will embrace is Roberto. In addition to a host of successful sons of Roberto currently standing in Kentucky, including Dynaformer, Kris S., Lear Fan, Red Ransom and Silver Hawk, recent additions give even more cause for hope. Claiborne Farm's recent acquisition of 1997 Epsom Derby winner Benny the Dip (Silver Hawk--Rascal Rascal, by Ack Ack), Vinery's English 2,000 Guineas winner Mister Baileys (Robellino--Thimblerigger, by Sharpen Up), Airdrie Stud's Metropolitan H. winner You and I (by Kris S. out of the South American champion La Chaposa, by Ups), and Lane's End Farm's Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Brocco (Kris S .-- Anytime Ms., by Aurelius), among others, place Roberto in a position to emerge as competition in a game that is now dominated by the Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer sirelines.

The two-day Keeneland July Sale begins tonight at 7 p.m. and continues Tuesday. Last year's auction saw 167 yearlings sell for an average of \$349,880, up 41.6 percent from 1995; the 1996 gross of \$58,430,000 was up 25.8 percent from the previous year.

Supplemented to this race, the filly Lady Alexander (GB) caused a major upset in beating 3-10 favorite King Of Kings (Ire), whose odds for next year's 2000 Guineas at Newmarket have been lengthened from 6-1 to at least 12-1 with most bookmakers. The colt had been talked about as the next Nijinsky II after his impressive eight-length debut victory here May 25, but only narrowly won the Railway S. June 29. Lady Alexander swept through to take the lead at the three-sixteenths pole, but the favorite was still under no sort of pressure and victory appeared assured. But, with his head in the air, he would not go through with his effort and although jockey Christy Roche only ever rode him with hands and heels, he was a major disappointment. Roche said later: "After three furlongs I didn't think the horse was travelling well. I deliberately didn't hit him, otherwise there would have been no horse for the future." Lady Alexander's delighted trainer Con Collins said: "I am very pleasantly surprised. The idea was to give her a crack at picking up some black type and I was pretty confident she would do that as she has been improving all the time, but this has come as a shock!" In contrast to Roche, Lady Alexander's rider Pat Shanahan was at his most forceful, too much so in fact for the stewards who gave him a three-day suspension for using the whip "with excessive force and frequency."
