\$1.05 MILLION FILLY TOPS KEENELAND

OPENER Demi O'Byrne dominated the buying at yesterday's first session of Keeneland's 1997 July Selected Yearling Sale, purchasing two yearlings for seven figures and four of the top ten priced horses. The session topper was hip number 55, a chestnut filly by champion sprinter Gulch out of the multiple graded stakes winning Lyphard mare Sabin. The filly, consigned by Calumet Farm, brought a final bid of \$1,050,000 from O'Byrne. The Irishman had to go to \$1,000,000 to take home the highest-priced colt of the session, hip number 50. The colt, by Storm Cat--Quite Honestly, by Believe It, was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent for Norfields. O'Byrne said both the colt and filly were bought for Michael Tabor and John Magnier. When asked about immediate plans for the pair, O'Byrne said, "We'll decide after the sale." About the seven-figure price tags, he commented, "It's very hard to predict these things, isn't it?" The session topper was another sign of the increasing presence of Calumet Farm at the sales. Of the farm's move to a higher profile in the market, Calumet's Neil Howard commented, "In the beginning it was very difficult, but in '95-'96 we sold all but two horses, so we proved to the industry that we were in the selling business." While Calumet redefines itself, the first day of the Keeneland sale was also noted for the new faces. Guided by Prince Ahmed Salman, Mohammed Alesayi made his first foray into the world of equine ownership. The international businessman paid \$525,000 for his first horse, hip number 24, a colt by A.P. Indy consigned by Eaton Sales, agent for Dr. Hiram C. Polk, Jr. and Dr. J. David Richardson. Cheveley Park Stud, Ltd. got the sale off to a fast start, paying \$950,000 for hip number 3, a dark bay filly, by Mr. Prospector--Heart of Joy, by Lypheor (GB). Shortly afterward, the English farm paid \$525,000 for hip number 8, a half sister to champion **Serena's Song** (Rahy) by Irish River (Fr)--Imagining, by Northfields. As for future plans for the pair of fillies, Chris Richardson, general manager for Cheveley Park, said, "Both fillies will return to England and will be trained there, and, we hope, eventually compliment our broodmare band." Keeneland sold 91 horses during Monday night's session for \$33,450,000, an average of \$367,582. The average was up 22.9 percent from last year's opening session when 81 horses brought \$24,230,000, an average of \$299,136. The sale concludes Tuesday.

The three-year-old stretches out off that effort. **Kirkwall (GB)** (Selkirk) has also lost only once this year, going four-for-five to date. The colt took a Group 3 race two starts back, then took on Group 1 company and finished third in the nine-furlong Prix Jean Prat in his latest June 1. **Romanov (Ire)** (Nureyev) was third in the Irish 2000 Guineas in May and again in the Epsom Derby June 7.
