SILVER CHARM OUT OF HASKELL

Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. winner Silver Charm (Silver Buck) will be forced to miss the August 3 GI Buick Haskell Invitational and a chance for some revenge against Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), the colt who denied him the Triple Crown in the Belmont S., after blood tests revealed a high white blood cell count. Silver Charm, who missed a scheduled work two weeks ago with a minor illness, may not race again until December. "There was no fever or anything, but his white count was elevated," trainer Bob Baffert explained. "So, he's still fighting something off. I'm going to have to give him another week off and then put him on some serious antibiotics. If I do that, I can't run him. I called (owner) Bob (Lewis) up and said that if we miss the Haskell, it's going to be too hard to get him ready for a mile and a quarter (in the Travers) on works. I don't want to run him when he's not right." Taking a cautious approach with his star colt, Baffert said the plan is to turn Silver Charm out at Bradbury Farm in Arcadia, California until he decides to resume serious training. "We'll put him in a nice grass paddock and let him get over whatever he has," the trainer said. Baffert said a possible target for Silver Charm's return could be in the Strub Series at Santa Anita, which begins with the December 26 Malibu S.

MEADOWLANDS STAKES SHAKE-UP The Meadowlands Racetrack has taken the Pegasus H. off the turf and increased its purse to \$1 million in an effort to attract the top three-year-olds to the New Jersey track. In order to raise the \$800,000 purse increase, the \$750,000 Meadowlands Cup for older horses has been dropped from the 1997 Meadowlands Stakes schedule. An announcement on the date for the new version of the 1997 Pegasus is expected to be made next week, but the race will probably be run near the beginning of the meet which opens September 6. "We'll have an important three-year-old race in September and are looking to fill a spot vacated by the Woodbine Million," said Hal Handel, executive vice president and chief operating officer of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. The Pegasus will no longer be sponsored by the Breeders' Cup and the \$100,000 in Breeders' Cup purse money designated for the race will now be added to the Oct. 17 GIII Long Look Breeders' Cup and the Sept. 5 GIII Honey Bee Breeders' Cup H.

TURFWAY/CHURCHILL GROUP BUYS

DUELING GROUNDS BC Racing Group, LLC, a group of investors which includes Churchill Downs Incorporated and Turfway Park Racing Association, Inc., purchased Dueling Grounds Racecourse for \$11 million at a Federal Bankruptcy Court auction yesterday in Louisville. Turfway Park, which has acted as interim manager of Dueling Grounds, will continue to oversee daily operation of the facility. Other investors include Bowling Green, Kentucky, businessman Brad Kelley, W. Brent Rice, Lexington, Kentucky and Multi-Venture Partners Ltd., a private investment concern. "It is our goal to revitalize Dueling Grounds and strengthen this 'link' on Kentucky's racing circuit," said Alexander M. Waldrop, senior vice president, Churchill Downs. "We are confident that through our ownership and operation of Dueling Grounds, we can ensure the integrity of its racing operations and its contribution to the future health of Kentucky racing." The track, plunged into bankruptcy in August 1996, is located in Franklin, Kentucky, just north of Nashville, Tennessee.

MYSTERY STORM MOVES TO DIXIANA FARM

Hart Farm and David Beard have announced that they will be relocating Mystery Storm (Storm Bird) from Hart Farm in Ocala, Florida to Dixiana Farm near Lexington, Kentucky. The five-year-old stallion, winner of the GIII Rebel S. and GIII Southwest S. at three, began his stud career last year, serving full books of mares in 1996 and 1997. "We are excited about Mystery Storm moving to Kentucky and feel he will be one of the best sons of Storm Bird in the area," said Bruce Kline, Dixiana's president and cosyndicate manager for the horse. "His foals are simply outstanding," Kline added. Mystery Storm, a winner of \$325,580 and seven starts in his 15-race career, is being syndicated by Needham/Betz Thoroughbreds and Dixiana Farm and will stand for \$7,500 live foal due September 1.

IRS WINS DEVIL HIS DUE RULING A Federal judge in Syracuse, New York, has decided that Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) was the sole property of Robert LiButti, convicted in 1977 of filing false tax returns. In 1995, Judge Thomas McAvoy had ruled that the horse, winner of \$3,920,405, belonged to LiButti's daughter Edith, but his decision was vacated by the United States Circuit Court of Appeals, which sent the case back to McAvoy. The IRS said it can now renew efforts to collect on the horse's value. The eight-year-old horse, whose first crop of foals was born this year, has a stud fee of \$20,000.


