THOMAS MELLON EVANS DEAD The *New York Times* reports that Thomas Mellon Evans, financier and Thoroughbred owner and breeder, passed away at his home in Manhattan Thursday due to complications from a recent fall. He was 86. Owner of Buckland Farm, Evans bought a cattle ranch in Virginia in 1956, but switched the focus of the operation to Thoroughbreds in 1964 and went on to breed champions Pleasant Tap; Pleasant Stage, winner of the 1991 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies; and Pleasant Colony, who took the Kentucky Derby and Preakness in 1981. Evans is survived by his wife, Betty Barton Evans; sons Thomas Jr., Edward and Robert; four grandchildren; and two stepchildren.

GARY STEVENS RETURNS TO ASCOT Jockey Gary Stevens will return to Ascot next Saturday to partner Godolphin's **Predappio (GB)** (Polish Precedent) in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Stevens was on board **Predappio** when the pair upset the hot favourite **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent) in the G2 Hardwicke S. over the same track and distance June 20, the rider's sole success at the four-day Royal Ascot meeting. **Predappio** is expected to face '96 Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Pilsudski** again in the King George; other probable runners are champion **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King), the likely favorite; Japan Cup and Dubai World Cup winner **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}); and 1996 Coronation Cup winner **Swain (GB)** (Nashwan), runner-up in the G2 Princess Of Wales S. July 8.

NEVADA-CALIFORNIA IMPASSE RESOLVED Simulcasting of Thoroughbred racing from California to Nevada casinos will resume when the Del Mar meeting opens July 23 due to an agreement announced Thursday. The agreement, reached between the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, the Nevada Pari-Mutuel Association and Thoroughbred Owners of California, breaks an eight-month impasse over California's share of the betting handle at Nevada casinos for races simulcast from the state. Under the terms of the new pact, California tracks will be compensated on an ascending scale under which an increase in handle will result in a corresponding increase in the rate paid by the Nevada casinos. While the arrangement initially applies to the Del Mar meet, the TOC has agreed to approve the same terms for all simulcasting contracts between NPMA and California tracks for the next year, and the NPMA has agreed to offer the same ascending scale to all tracks in the state.

July 5, owner Wafic Said Friday confirmed that Britain's champion jockey Pat Eddery will partner the four-year-old in her future races. Eddery was on board **Bosra Sham** when the pair won last year's 1000 Guineas and Champion S. at Newmarket. Eddery said: "I've been lucky to ride for Mr. Said before and I've known his racing manager, Tim Bulwer-Long, for some 20 years, so I'm delighted to be riding for him again. At present I'm retained until the end of the season, but obviously I'd like it to be an on-going situation." **Bosra Sham**'s next target is expected to be the G1 Juddmonte International at York August 18.
