### "AMERICAN" GIRL: COACHING CLUB

TO AJINA A distant third in the first leg of Belmont Park's Triple Tiara, the GI Acorn S., Ajina (Strawberry Road {Aus}) was 18-1 in the GI Mother Goose S. June 21 but shocked the crowd to earn her first Grade I win, and she put them back-to-back with a win in the Coaching Club American Oaks yesterday afternoon. The evenmoney second choice in the final jewel in the Tiara, the Bill Mott trainee was the only speed in the race and found herself alone on the lead through moderate fractions; she had six lengths on the field at the top of the stretch and easily held favored Tomisue's Delight (A.P. Indy) safe to post a 2 1/4-length victory. "I think that winning the Mother Goose was a confidence builder and definitely helped her out today," said jockey Mike Smith, who was aboard the filly for the first time in the Mother Goose. "It didn't look like there was a lot of pace out there, so I wanted to take her to the lead right away. She got there very easy. She finished strong and I'm looking for even better things from her." The two will team up once again in the Gl Alabama S. at Saratoga August 16.

BLUSHING K.D. HEADED FOR HASKELL Top three-year-old filly Blushing K.D. (Blushing John), who capped off a five-race winning streak that began in February with a victory in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2, will take on the colts in her next start, the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 3. The Kentucky-bred miss started her skein with a 20-length laugher over the boys in the Fair Grounds Sales Derby; she has already shown an affinity for the Jersey track, taking the GII Monmouth Park Breeders' Cup Oaks in her latest effort July 5 to run her record to eight-for-10 lifetime. "Fillies don't get the same opportunities to run for the big money like the boys," said trainer Sam David Jr. "She showed she can handle the Monmouth racing surface and she loved stabling there. This is a good time to try the colts. My filly is on top of her game.

Ajina ended 1996 with victories in the GIII Tempted S. and GII Demoiselle S. at Aqueduct but couldn't find her best stride in her first four starts at three. Beaten an average of nearly 11 1/2 lengths while picking up checks in stakes at Gulfstream, Oaklawn, Churchill and Belmont, the filly finally woke up with a 1 1/4-length win over Sharp Cat in the GI Mother Goose S. last out and she proved that race no fluke with another strong performance here. Allowed to set an uncontested pace, the dark bay opened it up on the far turn and then coasted home. "I can honestly say that I had a lot more confidence in her today than I did going into the Mother Goose," said trainer Bill Mott. "After losing four straight...it was somewhat disappointing, but she seems to be living up to expectations. We're very high on her right now." Tomisue's Delight, still looking for her first stakes wins after finishing second in the GI Kentucky Oaks and third in the Mother Goose, once again closed well but could not threaten the winner. "The slow pace definitely hurt," said trainer Neil Howard. "Maybe one of these days she'll get a pace that will help her late close. She might have a few more seconds than you'd like, but we're not complaining. We were very pleased with her today." If all goes well, the top two will meet again in Saratoga's Gl Alabama at a mile and a quarter August 16.

Smoke Glacken won the June 7 Glll Riva Ridge S. at Belmont and then June 28 GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth in front-running style. Taking on older horses for the first time here, the overwhelming favorite set a fast pace while racing off the rail before widening the margin around the far turn and digging in to hold the lead late over Wise Dusty. "I thought it might be Political Whit who would push him," winning trainer Henry Carroll said. "But he didn't seem to be the one. I asked several trainers around here and they seemed to think that from the five-sixteenths pole home to stay in the three-path. That's what I told Craig (Perret) to do. His next start should be in the King's Bishop S. on August 23 at Saratoga." Said co-owner Bob Levy, "He's good. He's not Housebuster, but he's good. I don't know about supplementing to the Breeders' Cup. We'll see how it goes." Capote Belle raced from just off the pace but did not threaten. "I asked her to run just past the three-eighths pole and wanted to get to the outside," said her rider, Robby Albarado. "But I had to stay down on the rail because Wise Dusty had already taken the outside position. When I asked her to run inside the quarter pole she gave her all, but just couldn't get to the winner."



Champion jockey Frankie Dettori, who will be married today, celebrated the occasion with a fine front-running success on Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's homebred filly Anno Luce (GB) (Old Vic {GB}) in Saturday's Listed Food Brokers Aphrodite S. at Newmarket. But the 26-year-old also collected a three-day suspension for what the stewards termed was "careless riding" on Daawe (Danzig) in the Chemist Broker H. on the same card. Dettori is suspended from July 28-30, so will miss the first two days of the prestigious five-day Goodwood meeting. He will marry 23-year-old University Of Surrey graduate Catherine Allen, a horsewoman herself who specializes in three-day eventing and has also regularly ridden work for Newmarket trainer David Loder. The couple will marry at the Catholic church Our Lady Immaculate and St. Etheldreda in Newmarket. Although they had planned to delay their honeymoon until later in the year because of Dettori's hectic riding schedule, they can perhaps, thanks to the suspension, take at least a three-day midsummer break.

Before the break, however, Dettori will ride Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's Shantou (Alleged) in Saturday's G1 \$819,403 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, rather than continue his association with the same owner's Singspiel (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), on whom he had won both the 1996 Japan Cup and this season's Coronation Cup.
