"FREE" AT LAST: FREE HOUSE TAKES SWAPS He set the pace but weakened to be third in the Kentucky Derby...ran his heart out but had to settle for second in the Preakness...and put in yet another gallant effort to be third in the grueling mile-and-a-half of the Belmont S. But the eyecatching grey Free House (Smokester) was back in the winner's circle after a stakes record-setting performance in yesterday's GII Swaps S. at Hollywood Park. Without Silver Charm or Touch Gold to contend with, the unfashionably bred Californian had the field at his mercy, pursuing pacesetters Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister) (second) and Wild Rush (Wild Again) (third) for six furlongs before pouncing as they headed into the stretch and racing away to a 3 1/2-length victory. The time for the nine furlongs was 1:45 4/5, just three ticks off the track record. "This guy was ready," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux, "(Trainer Paco Gonzalez) had him conditioned to perfection. This was his easiest win. I was very confident. He was in the bridle--he led me to believe that he was just waiting on the call, and he got the call." Free House could ship to Saratoga for his next start, the 3 Travers S. August 23. The Swaps was marred when Hello (Ire) (Lycius) broke down just past the eighth pole. The colt suffered a compound fracture of the left front cannon bone and had to be put down. His jockey, Chris McCarron, was taken to Centinella Medical Center complaining of pain in his left shoulder and collar bone.

ATTENDANCE AND HANDLE UP AT BELMONT

The daily average for both on-track attendance and total handle showed improvement at the Belmont Park springsummer meeting which concluded Sunday. Daily average attendance rose 7.3 percent, from 8,707 in 1996 to 9,339 this year, while total daily average handle was up 4.4 percent, from \$9,094,922 in '96 to \$9,489,536 in '97. On-track, the daily average handle was \$2,135,644, down 1.4 percent from a year ago. "We're pleased with the upturn in attendance and total handle and hope that this meet's number is evidence that the downturn in on-track handle in recent years has leveled off," said New York Racing Association President and Chief Operating Officer Terry Meyocks. "It is something we plan to continue to build on. We've been trying to provide a better product and environment for our customers...we want to reach more people with our message that Thoroughbred racing can be enjoyed by the entire family and at a reasonable cost."

Twice The Vice ended her 1996 campaign with a fourth-place finish to eventual champion Jewel Princess in this race, but turned the tables in this edition. Runnerup in the GI Hempstead H. at Belmont last out after opening the season with a win in the GII Hawthorne H. May 25, the six-year-old came away from the gate with the lead and set the pace under pressure, then held off the hard-knocking Real Connection at the wire to take the photo. "She was just in a high gallop, traveling so comfortable," said jockey Kent Desormeaux, who picked up his second graded win of the afternoon after picking up the mount from the very unlucky Chris McCarron, who was injured when Hello (Ire) broke down in the Swaps and so lost out on three graded stakes wins on the card. (See Sunset H., Hollywood Juvenile Championship S.) "She's got that stride from here to kingdom come. It was just a horse race from the half-mile pole on and I felt I was on the best one." As for the future, trainer Ron Ellis said, "We may run her at Del Mar or wait until Oak Tree. Our focus is the Breeders' Cup." Jewel Princess, the 4-5 chalk, ran an even third. "We're going to turn her out a while and we'll bring her back in the fall," said trainer Wally Dollase. "We'll probably get her one or two races before the Breeders' Cup."

Looking for his first win since taking the GI Santa Anita Derby April 5 but coming off a Triple Crown campaign that saw him on the board in every jewel, Cal-bred Free House was the overwhelming favorite to celebrate his return to his home state with a return to the winner's circle. Three-wide while rating just off the pace, the crowd's choice picked up the leaders at the top of the stretch and galloped home. "What a Cal-bred," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "This is a wonderful horse. These seven weeks after the Belmont, he was doing really good. This race is going to do even more for him. He's going to get his confidence back." The colt is likely to head East again for the GI Travers at a mile and a quarter August 23. As for not facing Silver Charm again this year, Gonzalez said, "It's too bad. It's bad for the business. For (Free House, Silver Charm and Touch Gold) to get together again would've been great for the crowd."

Already winner of the GII San Luis Rey and GI San Juan Capistrano H. this year, the Florida-bred bay wasted no time taking the lead and was never headed, holding off longshot Flyway (Fr) down the lane for a decisive score. Jockey David Flores picked up the mount from the injured Chris McCarron. "This is a horse I've always wanted to ride," said Flores. "I worked him, and he was so nice, such a pro--just one of those classy horses that comes to run. And the farther this horse goes, the better he gets." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said the colt could go next in the GI Arlington Million August 24.
