HELISSIO SPARKLES IN CHANTILLY

WORKOUT French-trained four-year-old **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King), a 6-4 shot with most bookmakers for Saturday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, proved he is ready for the test with a sparkling mile-and-an-eighth workout at Chantilly over the weekend. The colt was partnered by Texan Cash Asmussen, who said: "He went very nicely. I am full of confidence for Ascot, but it is a great field and everything in it deserves plenty of respect. **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) and **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent) have a line of form that comes up very good and I have a lot of respect for **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan). But I sure wouldn't swap my horse for any of them." Eight horses have accepted for Saturday's big Ascot race; also entered are **Predappio (GB)** (Polish Precedent), **Shantou (Alleged)**, three-year-old **Kingfisher Mill (Riverman)** and **Strategic Choice (Alleged)**.

WINDSHARP RETIRED Windsharp (Lear Fan), champion-turf mare and older mare in Canada last year and runner-up in the voting for the distaff turf Eclipse Award, has been retired due to a strained tendon, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. The six-year-old mare was injured in winning what would be her final career start, the G1 Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood June 29. Imported from France where she was twice placed in listed stakes, the Kentucky-bred dark bay won six of 16 starts in North America, including the G1 San Luis Rey and GII San Luis Obispo H. against colts last year; she was three-for-four this year, adding the Beverly Hills to wins in the GII Santa Ana H. and Estrapade S. She goes to the breeding shed with a total of 11 wins from 29 starts and earnings of \$1,290,495.

Crystal Hearted (GB) made this wire-to-wire win his second success of the season. The three-year-old won the Listed Dee S. at Chester May 8, but was then only 12th in the English Derby June 8. He set out under jockey Tony McGlone to make this a true test of stamina. With two furlongs left to run, the odds-on favorite Fahris (Ire) moved up to challenge the long-time leader, but Crystal Hearted fought back bravely and managed to score by a neck. Michael Poland, whose wife owns Crystal Hearted, was delighted with the result. "He wasn't right when unplaced in the Derby and came back and slept for a few days," he said. "But we always had faith in him and thought that he had a good chance this afternoon. Tony has ridden a fine tactical race here, dominating from the front. He is a very gutsy horse. I was a bit worried that the ground would be too lively for him, however I think that the other two runners did not enjoy it either." Crystal Hearted will be aimed at the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville August 16.

CHURCHILL ANNOUNCES FALL STAKES

SCHEDULE The fall stakes schedule at Churchill Downs, which includes purse increases for four graded races, will be worth \$2 million for 1997. The 108th Fall Meet offers 11 stakes, 10 of them graded. Getting the largest purse hike is the Gill Clark H., a nine-furlong test for three-year-olds and up to be run November 28 which has been raised from \$250,000-added to \$400,000-added. "The Clark is as old as the Kentucky Derby and we want it to be a marquee event in the fall," said Churchill Downs Vice President of Racing Don Richardson. Getting \$50,000 raises are the Gill Cardinal H., Gill Gill River City H. and Gill Mrs. Revere S., which will be worth \$150,000-added each this year. The 1997 Churchill Fall Meet runs from October 26-November 29.

Latin Dancer had won three of his last four races, taking the San Pedro S. on the dirt and the Gill Baldwin S. and most recently the Radar Ahead H. June 7, both on turf. The second choice here, the bay Maryland-bred rated midpack to the stretch, then rallied up the rail to take the lead late and win going away. "He's a good horse," said trainer Randy Bradshaw. "His races on turf have been pretty good, but that race on dirt in the San Pedro was probably his best. The main thing is to keep him sprinting." The 3-5 favorite SANDTRAP (Irish River {Fr}) broke a step slowly and was steadied during the early stages of the race, was caught in traffic on the far turn, then drifted out when finally clear in the stretch and finished fourth. "When he got to the sixteenth pole, he switched leads and took a bad step," said his jockey Alex Solis. "He felt a little funny after that. He just took a bad step. It was one of those things."

The well-traveled **Anet** (Clever Trick), winner of the USA S. at Lone Star Park in his latest July 5 after finishing as runner-up in the Gil Ohio Derby at Thistledown and the Gil Illinois Derby at Sportsman's Park, will be back on the road for his next start. The colt worked seven furlongs in 1:24 3/5 at Del Mar yesterday morning, prompting trainer Bob Baffert to remark, "Well, he just won himself a trip to the Haskell." The three-year-old will ship to Monmouth Park for the GI Buick Haskell Invitational August 3.

Jockey Chris McCarron, injured when **Hello (Ire)** (Lycius) broke down in Sunday's Swaps S., suffered a bruised left shoulder and will miss the first two days of the Del Mar meet, which opens Wednesday.

Louis Eilken, a California racing official for nearly 50 years and a former director of racing at Del Mar, died Sunday after a lengthy illness. He was 82.
