KEENELAND NOVEMBER SALE DATE

CHANGED Keeneland's annual November Breeding Stock Sale will begin Monday, November 10. The opening session was previously scheduled for November 9. "By starting on Monday for 1997, it will enable people to travel to Kentucky from California and eliminate any conflict with the Breeders' Cup," explained Rogers Beasley, Keeneland Director of Sales. Entries for the sale close August 1. Once the number of horses to be sold is determined, the length of the sale will be announced.

CHEQUER RETIRED TO VINERY Graded stakes winner **Chequer** (Mr. Prospector) has been retired from racing and will stand the 1998 breeding season at Mr. and Mrs. Ben P. Walden, Jr.'s Vinery in Midway, Kentucky. The five-year-old stallion won last year's GIII William P. Kyne H. and ran third in the 1994 G2 Criterium De Maisons-Laffitte in France in the colors of Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum. Chequer retires with four wins in 13 starts for earnings of \$179,689. "We feel privileged to be extended this opportunity by Sheikh Mohammed to stand Chequer, a high class racehorse with the highest class pedigree," Ben Walden, Jr. said. Chequer will stand for a fee of \$7,500 live foal as the property of Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud Management.

Polished Brass broke his maiden at third asking, besting a field at Churchill June 29. Stepping right into graded stakes company off that victory, the chestnut was with the leaders from the start, moved to challenge favored Double Honor in the stretch and prevailed in a hard-fought finish to give trainer Pat Byrne his second stakes win of the two-day old meet. "When I called on him he took a little longer to respond than I would have liked, but he was up to the task and came on running," said winning rider Pat Day. "He has a marvelous mind and tactical speed. His attitude and disposition are in his favor." Byrne said the colt would run back in the GII Saratoga Special August 13. D. Wayne Lukas, trainer of the beaten favorite said, "With 50 yards to go, it was anybody's race and we just got outfinished. We were not as tight as we'd like to be but we are definitely moving in the right direction." Lukas was not certain where Double Honor would start next.
