BLUSHING K.D. FRACTURES SESAMOID GI

Kentucky Oaks victoress Blushing K.D. (Blushing John) fractured her left front sesamoid while galloping at Monmouth Park yesterday morning. The three-yearold filly was preparing for next Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational. "There is a splint on her right now," reported Dr. Mark Ketner. "We'll keep her in the stall with the splint on and reevaluate her on a daily basis. Hopefully we can treat her conservatively." Trainer Sam David added, "It looks like there's a pretty good shot for saving her. She spotted another horse on the track, shot by him at the head of the lane, bolted and broke both sesamoids." Blushing K.D. won eight of 10 career starts for earnings of \$918,900. In addition to her Kentucky Oaks win--which propelled her to the top of the three-year-old filly division--Blushing K.D. scored victories in the GII Fantasy S. and GIII Fair Grounds Oaks. The filly captured the July 5 GII Monmouth Park Breeders' Cup Oaks in her last start.

ASCOT DOUBLE FOR STEVENS Hall of Fame jockey Gary Stevens landed a "double" victory at Ascot Saturday when he partnered the Paul Cole-trained four-year-old colt Present Arms (Affirmed) to win the Barney Barnato Diamond H. and the 7-year-old Tykevor (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}), trained by Lady Herries, to take the Venetia Diamond H. The wins made up for his disappointing seventh-place finish on Predappio (GB) (Polish Precedent) in the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Stevens nearly did not make it to England at all after his original flight was forced to turn back to America with engine trouble. He finally arrived in England Saturday morning at 6:00. Present Arms's trainer Paul Cole was delighted with Stevens's win: "It is a great win for Gary Stevens, who is a top-flight, high-profile jockey whom we like to see in the winner's enclosure over here. He gave the horse a really good ride."

At 16-1, Swain (Ire) pulled off a major surprise in beating his three main rivals and reversing last year's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe finish, when he ran third behind Helissio (Fr) and Pilsudski (Ire). He became the second longest-priced winner in the 47-year history of this event. It was no easy win for the five-year-old, who took the 1996 G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom and has now won 8 of his 14 lifetime starts. He tracked Helissio and KINGFISHER MILL (Riverman) early on, with Pilsudski close up in fourth. On the final turn Helissio still led, but Swain's rider John Reid sent his mount through to challenge and soon gained the lead from the French-trained favorite. He then had to battle hard on the rain-softened ground to withstand the finish of Pilsudski, whom he outstayed bravely to the wire. Helissio fought back to earn third place, ahead of the disappointing Singspiel (Ire), whose chances were handicapped by the soft ground. Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, head of the Godolphin team, said: "Before the rain came I thought Singspiel would win, but I knew these conditions would favor Swain." Swain's rider John Reid said: "It was a fantastic race. They called it the 'race of the century' and I can't believe I've won it. Swain was always travelling well behind the leaders and I knew he was strong and once I took the lead it was going to be tough to catch me. He ran all the way to the wire." Swain is now to be prepared for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, followed by the Breeders' Cup Turf at Hollywood Park. Pilsudski's trainer Michael Stoute said "You have to be happy with that effort. He's a brave horse and I'm sure he's been beaten by a champion. I thought he'd win turning for home, but Swain outstaved us."

Fabulously Fast came off of a seven-month layoff to win a back-to-back New York allowance races in May and June before a second-place finish in a July 2 Belmont allowance event. The winner rated on the outside before moving up four wide around the far turn to take the lead in the stretch and then drew off. "As soon as I slapped her she went," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "He (trainer John Kimmel) had her sharp today. She was focused and knew what she was there for." Winning trainer John Kimmel said, "This filly really got over early behavior problems and settled down. She schooled four times this week. She didn't waste any energy in the post parade. Being relaxed allows a horse to give a 100 percent effort." Kimmel indicated that the winner will be given the rest of the Saratoga meet off and may run next some time in September.

Famous Digger was looking for her third straight win after taking the GIII Honeymoon H. in May and the June 22 Variety Queen H. in her last start. The bay filly stalked the early leaders, took a short lead entering the stretch and drew clear to the wire. "I was worried about going a mile," admitted winning trainer Barry Abrams. "That's not her best distance. It's when they go a mile and an eighth, a mile and a half, that's when you'll see what she's made out of. Basically she just galloped around there and when (jockey) Brice (Blanc) asked her to run on the turn, she just went right by them." Abrams said the August 17 GI Del Mar Oaks would be next for Famous Digger.
