"HIDDEN" TALENT TAKES GO FOR

WAND She was 8-1 when she captured the Gll Shuvee H. in May and 9-2 taking the GI Hempstead H. in June, but the talented Hidden Lake (Quiet American) won't get by the bettors again. The four-year-old was the 3-5 favorite in vesterday's GI Go For Wand S. at Saratoga and picked up her third straight stakes with a game head decision over stablemate Flat Fleet Feet (Afleet). The gallant filly did give her connections a scare as jockey Richie Migliore pulled her up and jumped off soon after the finish of the race. "She was nodding and wobbly from the heat," explained Migliore. Suffering from heat exhaustion, the bay was treated immediately and seemed to have recovered before she was led off the track. "We got ice water and a hose on her," said trainer John Kimmel, who is also a licensed veterinarian. "A quick exam of her legs revealed no serious injury." The victory was Kimmel's second Grade I win of the five-day-old Saratoga meet after saddling Fabulously Fast to an eyecatching score in the GI Test S. Saturday. "You've got to pinch yourself to believe you've won two Grade I's in a weekend," he said. "It's just a real pleasure to be in the business." The trainer added that Hidden Lake had earned herself a rest and would not start again until September.

BLUSHING K.D. IMPROVES Top three-year-old filly **Blushing K.D.** (Blushing John), who fractured the sesamoids in her left front leg while galloping Saturday morning at Monmouth Park, was holding her own yesterday and trainer Sam David Jr. was optimistic about her future. "With the way she looks and the way she's handling it, I think we're in pretty good shape," he said. "Right now our main concern is keeping the blood supply going to her hoof. We don't believe that any arteries are damaged. I feel a lot better than I did yesterday." Plans right now do not include surgery, but David said the filly would be X-rayed again in about two weeks to assess her progress. News cont. p2

Bidding for her third consecutive graded stakes score, Hidden Lake was coming off a victory over top mares Twice The Vice and Jewel Princess in the GI Hempstead H. at Belmont Park June 28. The crowd's odds-on choice broke on top and set the early pace on a clear lead, then was joined by stablemate Flat Fleet Feet and the two battled head-and-head down the Saratoga stretch before the favorite prevailed in a photo. The stretch duel took its toll as the winner had to be treated for heat exhaustion, but she appeared to be okay after getting cooled down with ice water and a cold hose and left the track under her own power. As for the race, trainer John Kimmel said, "Hidden Lake dug down and found something extra. She's a special kind of filly. I thought Flat Fleet Feet was going to win inside the eighth pole." The runner-up, who has never been worse than second in six starts at the Spa, was making her first start at a mile and an eighth. "She was a bit of a question mark going a mile and an eighth around two turns, but she put in a magnificent performance," said Kimmel. "We were originally going to run her back in the Ballerina (at seven furlongs), but she may have earned another program. Hopefully we can map out a program to get her to the big dance."






