WILL'S WAY PREVAILS IN WHITNEY Repeating the Saratoga successes of his champion sire, Will's Way (Easy Goer) earned a hard-fought victory over Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) in vesterday's Gl Whitney H. at Saratoga Racecourse. Easy Goer, champion two-year-old of 1988, earned a Saratoga double in the 1989 GI Travers and GI Whitney and his son returned to the upstate New York track a year after taking the Travers to complete his own double. The Whitney marked the third straight meeting for Will's Way, Skip Away (Skip Trial) and Formal Gold. Skip Away, who had defeated his two rivals in the GIII Massachusetts H. and GII Suburban, was made the even-money choice, but never threatened the top two, Formal Gold, second in the MassCap and third in the Suburban, led from the start but Will's Way was never far back. At the top of the stretch, Formal Gold's advantage dwindled to a head and the fight was on. The pair was inseparable down the stretch, but Will's Way put a determined nose in front just at the wire for the second Grade I win of his career. The victory came as no surprise to winning trainer H. James Bond. "I can honestly say that I knew he was going to run this good. Coming into the race, he was doing outstanding and he was training well. He really loves Saratoga and he loves this track." The Whitney win gave jockey Jerry Bailey his fifth winner at Saratoga yesterday. "That is something that is always special, but is extra special here in Saratoga because you have so many fans and so many owners watching," Bailey said of the feat.

#### LAWMAKERS PROPOSE NYRA FRANCHISE

**EXTENSION** A bill was introduced into both houses of the New York legislature Friday night that, if passed, would extend NYRA's franchise to operate racing at Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga until Dec. 31, 2007. NYRA's franchise currently expires Dec. 31, 2000. The same bill will provide for a minor increase in purses and will give OTB the opportunity to simulcast more races from outside New York state. Under the provisions in the bill, there will be unlimited simulcasting from midnight until 1 p.m, at which time OTB could take races from countries such as Hong Kong, England and Australia. OTB will also be allowed to accept bets on two out-of-state tracks during the hours NYRA is operating. Currently, they are allowed to take only one.

Will's Way kicked off his 1997 campaign with a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ length victory in a May 15 Belmont allowance race and then finished third in the May 31 GIII Massachusetts H. at Suffolk and second last time out in the July 4 GII Suburban H. at Belmont. The winner, who checked slightly while breaking outward a bit at the start, stalked the pace from just off the outside of pacesetting Formal Gold and challenged that rival on the far turn before battling heads apart down the stretch and prevailing at the wire. "When Formal Gold came out (around the first turn) he turned a six-horse race into a two-horse race," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "Skip Away got squeezed back and he had a lot to overcome, especially with 125 pounds on him. From that point on, all we had to do was to do whatever Formal Gold did. At the guarter-pole, I really felt we had the race won." Favored Skip Away tracked the leaders in third position before inching up on the far turn but lacked response in the stretch. "He was just a flat horse today," jockey Shane Sellers, aboard Skip Away, said. "I don't know if it was the track he didn't like or what." Trainer Sonny Hine indicated that Skip Away will run next in the Aug. 23 GII Iselin H. at Monmouth or Belmont's Sept. 20 GI Woodward S.
