“GOLDEN” SUNDAY FOR HOFMANS, STRONACH Sunday was a banner day for trainer David Hofmans, owner Frank Stronach and 1997 leading sire Deputy Minister. For starters, the three combined to send out Queen’s Plate hero **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister) to a three-length triumph in the GII Jim Dandy at Saratoga. Only 52 minutes later at Monmouth Park, Belmont Stakes champ **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister), trained by Hofmans and owned by Stronach and Stonerside Stable, overpowered his four rivals to win the \$1 million Buick Haskell. As physics prevented Hofmans from being in two places at once, the conditioner watched **Awesome Again’s** effort on T.V. from Monmouth Park, where he took in Touch Gold’s dramatic victory live. “I’ve never seen a three-year-old run by **Free House** (Smokester) like that,” Hofmans said of Touch Gold’s Buick Haskell performance. “I think it will be close for champion three-year-old. This couldn’t have gone any better. It was a great lunch, a great place, with great people and I’m driving a Buick.” Touch Gold’s jockey Chris McCarron added, “If you saw this horse’s first and third work after the Belmont you would say he had no chance. He took a big step towards the Eclipse Award. I have to give all the credit to David Hofmans to get this horse ready for his last two races. This may be the best horse I’ve been on.”

CHANGE OF PLANS FOR SANDPIT Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), whose seven U.S. graded stakes wins have all come on turf, will return to that surface for his next start, the GI Arlington Million Aug. 24. The chestnut, third in his most recent outing, the GI Hollywood Gold Cup on the dirt June 29, had been pointing to Saturday’s GI Pacific Classic over Del Mar’s main track. Assistant trainer Gary Mandella explained the change of plans: “Mr. Meneces (owner Sergio Meneces of Sierra Thoroughbreds) decided he’d like to have a fresh horse in the Arlington Million. He believes a win could salvage (an Eclipse Award as) top grass horse for Sandpit.”

Touch Gold was sent off the slight favorite here after winning the Belmont S. in his last start June 7. The only question mark was fitness, as he was coming off a two-month hiatus. That question was answered as Touch Gold, ridden for the third straight time by Chris McCarron, trailed the tightly-bunched field of five until the top of the stretch, where McCarron guided him through an opening and past his rivals to win going away. ANET, who set the pace early through fractions of :22 3/5 and :46 1/5, held on to be second. “He got beat by a better horse, plain and simple,” said Anet’s trainer Bob Baffert. FREE HOUSE, coming into the Buick Haskell off only two weeks rest after taking the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood July 20, raced up near the leaders throughout but lacked a closing bid. The gray’s trainer Paco Gonzalez contended, “You did not see the real Free House today. Yes, I’m very disappointed because he didn’t run his race.” Previously undefeated TALE OF THE CAT (Storm Cat), trying stakes company for the first time, reached the lead after six furlongs but conceded it in midstretch, settling for fourth. “The more they run the better they get,” said trainer John Forbes. “I’m so proud of him. He ran a phenomenal race. He’s the fastest horse I’ve ever trained. We might go in the (Aug. 23) Travers. We just have to wait and see.”

Expelled began his racing career in France, where he won the G3 Prix du Bois in June, 1994. He then travelled to the U.S. for his 1996 campaign, and has remained here ever since. Coming into this event, the dark bay had made only six Stateside starts--all against allowance company--with three victories. Trying North American stakes company for the first time here, he sprinted to the early lead, was permitted to crawl on the front end through fractions of :25 and :48 4/5, then had plenty left in the late stages to pull off the upset. "We figured out that he needed to be on the lead so we started sending him to the lead," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "I thought he was beat in the middle of the stretch when they came to him, but he found another gear and finished very well. I don't think we'll go to the Arlington Million, but we may go in the Breeders' Cup Mile." Expelled's victory was Frankel's 7th in the Eddie Read. 3-2 favorite MARLIN was Expelled's closest pursuer throughout much of the race, but couldn't provide the necessary late response to propel himself past the first two finishers. "He wasn't handling it (the turf course)," said Marlin's jockey Corey Nakatani. "It was too deep and soft for him. He got third on class alone."

Awesome Again lived up to his name here for the second straight time after capturing the June 29 GIC Queen's Plate at Woodbine in only his third career start. Sent off the 3-1 second choice, the eventual winner raced well back early, moved up along the rail around the far turn and then angled outside to make a powerful stretch rally which swept him to the lead to win going away. "It's really amazing what this horse has done considering he's only had four starts so far," winning jockey Mike Smith said. "Each situation that comes up is a new one and he handles it without a problem. He ran such a good race, and he's still running a little green. He made up so much ground in the stretch and the last sixteenth, he was just playing out there." Favored BEHRENS (Pleasant Colony), winner of all three of his previous starts including the July 5 GII Dwyer S., never threatened the leaders, finishing fourth. "He broke in at the start and hit the side of the gate hard," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "We had some trouble, but all-in-all, I think it was a good effort that he will improve off of." Trainer H. James Bond indicated that Behrens will run next in the Aug. 23 GI Travers. S. at Saratoga. Third-place finisher Affirmed Success also remains a possibility for the Travers.

PACIFIC CLASSIC HOPEFULS BREEZE **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), winner of his last two starts--the Pimlico Special May 10 and the Hollywood Gold Cup June 29--will try for his third straight Grade I victory in Saturday's \$1 million Pacific Classic at Del Mar. The Argentine champion breezed six furlongs in 1:13 yesterday morning over Del Mar's main track. "He did it very easy," said assistant trainer Gary Mandella. "He'll get a day off tomorrow and walk. Then he'll gallop up to the race." **Crafty Friend** (Crafty Prospector), coming off a victory in the GII Bel Air H. at Hollywood July 12, also tested the Del Mar course yesterday, going seven furlongs in 1:26 1/5 under regular jockey Alex Solis. "He was very relaxed out there," said trainer Wally Dollase. "Alex was pleased. He left him on the rail all the way. He said it was more tiring and he wanted to make sure the colt got something out of the work." **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}), runner-up to Gentlemen in the Hollywood Gold Cup, drilled seven-eighths at Del Mar Saturday in 1:27 2/5 in his final Pacific Classic prep. Also working for the race Saturday was **Percutant (GB)** (Perrault {GB}), who zipped five furlongs in :59 2/5. Percutant, winner of the listed Jim Murray H. over the Hollywood grass June 28, will be making his first start on dirt in the Pacific Classic.
