FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA YEARLING SALES **OPENS TODAY** Fasig-Tipton's 77th annual Saratoga Yearling Sales opens this evening at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York, The cover of this year's catalogue features 1995 graduate Sharp Cat, a multiple Grade I winner vying for year-end honors in the fathoms-deep three-year-old filly division and inside are 231 pedigrees of the colts and fillies buyers will be studying in search of their own Sharp Cats. Represented are such top sires as A.P. Indy, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Forty Niner, Gone West, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Unbridled and Woodman, as well as promising young stallions like Boundary, Dehere and Gilded Time. "I am most pleased with the fact that the physical quality of the horses we inspected in March and April has in nearly every case remained constant or even improved over the earlier inspections," said Terence Collier, Fasig-Tipton's Director of Marketing. "Overall, the physical quality of this catalogue is consistently high--one of the strongest we have had." Interest in the catalogue has also been strong. "I heard a very interesting statistic from Eaton Sales," said Collier. "The average number of times they have shown their vearlings this year has risen more than 20 percent from last year. We have a diverse group of buyers this year. We will have more Japanese participants and a strong contingent from Europe. And American trainers such as Wayne Lukas and John Kimmel will be major factors." At last year's sale, the average price was \$161,604 and the '96 median price was \$130,000. "We would like to sustain last year's market levels," said Collier. "The sale showed a major increase, made a major move forward last year. If we show even modest growth in average and gross this year, everybody would be very content." Bidding for the three-day auction begins at 8 p.m. tonight and continues the same time Wednesday and Thursday evenings.



#### STEVENS, EASY GOER INDUCTED TO HALL

OF FAME Jockey Gary Stevens and champion twoyear-old Easy Goer (Alydar) officially joined racing's pantheon vesterday at the Hall of Fame induction ceremony in the National Museum of Racing in Saratoga, New York. Also being inducted into the Hall of Fame were the filly Bold 'n Determined, 1936 Belmont S. victor Granville and trainers Philip Johnson and Mickey Walsh. During his speech at the ceremony, Stevens said, "Most importantly, thank you to the all the great horses I've ridden. Without the horses, none of us would be here right now; none of us would have the enjoyment we have day in and day out. It's the most special sport in the world."

#### AUSTRALIAN JOCKEY EXCHANGES SILKS

FOR CLOTH Champion jockey Darren Beadman has stunned the Australian racing fraternity with his decision to quit riding at the end of the year to become a Christian minister. The 31-year-old, who partnered Saintly (Aus) (Sky Chase {NZ}) to win both the G1 Cox Plate and G1 Melbourne Cup this season and who was aboard Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) for most of his Group 1 wins last year, said, "It's not what I want to do, it's what God wants me to do. I feel at such peace with the decision I've made because I know it's right, it's what God wants me to do. God has given me great gifts in riding, but that was only temporary. It was a foundation for the future." Beadman, who became a committed Christian three years ago, quits right at the very top of his profession, having ridden more than 1100 winners in his career, of which more than 500 have been in the past three seasons. He has partnered the winners of 46 Group 1 races, half of that number being in the past two seasons. He was champion apprentice twice in the 1980s and in 1994-95 he broke a 55-year-old record when riding 128 metropolitan winners in Sydney; that same season, he established a new record of 182 winners in the state of New South Wales.



SAINTLY TOP-WEIGHTED IN AUSTRALASIAN

CLASSIFICATIONS The four-year-old gelding Saintly (Aus) (Sky Chase {NZ}) has been rated above Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) in the 1996-97 Australia-New Zealand Classifications, which were announced Monday. Saintly, winner of the G1 Cox Plate and G1 Melbourne Cup, was given an overall rating of 62.5 kilos (138 pounds), a kilo ahead of Octagonal, the leading money earner in Australian racing history. Saintly is expected to return to racing next season, while Octagonal, who was voted the 1995-96 Horse Of The Year, has been retired to Woodlands Stud in New South Wales. The top-rated three-year-old with 61 kilos (134 pounds) was Octagonal's full-brother Mouawad (NZ), winner of seven of his eight starts including the G1 Australian Guineas, but also retired to stud in Queensland. Top-rated juvenile was the colt Encounter (Aus) (Tierce {Aus}) with 60 kilos (132 pounds).
