**SMOKE GLACKEN RETIRED** Trainer Henry Carroll said yesterday that the racing career of his talented three-year-old sprinter **Smoke Glacken** (Two Punch), who has come up with a chip in his knee, is likely finished. "It's 98 percent certain that he'll be retired," said Carroll. "The saddest thing is that he was only just beginning to reach his peak. He was just starting to mature. We felt that he was really going to be something next year." A winner of 10 of his 14 starts including the GII Frank J. DeFrancis Dash last time out, the roan had been scheduled to run next in the GII King's Bishop at Saratoga August 23. He will stand stud at Gainesway Farm in Lexington, Kentucky.

**DANZIG TOPS STALLION ACCESS SALE** As he did last year, premier sire **Danzig** (Northern Dancer) led the bidding at Fasig-Tipton's Stallion Access Champagne Sale of Selected Seasons and Shares, held last night at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York. Three 1998 no-guarantee nominations to the Claiborne Farm stallion were offered, bringing \$136,000, \$128,000 and \$125,000. A season to **Gulch** (Mr. Prospector), whose yearling colt sold for \$1.4 million to top Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga Yearling Sales, was next in the bidding, bringing \$49,000. In all, a total of 34 nominations grossed \$1,174,900, an average of \$34,556. The average was up 36.6 percent from last year's auction, when 46 seasons brought \$1,163,700, an average of \$25,298. There were 11 seasons listed as not sold this year.

**MONMOUTH DANGLES \$100,000 ISELIN BONUS** Monmouth Park officials announced yesterday that any Grade I winner since September 1, 1996 who wins this year's edition of the Philip H. Iselin H. will receive an additional \$100,000 bonus on top of the winner's share of the \$250,000 purse. The GII Iselin, to be run at the distance of a mile and a sixteenth, will have its 62nd renewal August 23.

**Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), three-for-four in 1997 and winner of seven of his last eight starts, may be the best horse in training in the country right now after capturing the May 10 GI Pimlico Special and the June 29 GI Hollywood Gold Cup by four lengths last time out. **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}) used his speed to his advantage in defeating Gentlemen in the Mar. 2 GI Santa Anita H. Runner-up in the Dubai World Cup in April, he came back to be second last time out in the Gold Cup. **River Keen (Ire)** (Keen {GB}) won four races on dirt in England in as many tries and then made his American debut a winning one, capturing the June 1 GII Californian S. at Hollywood in his previous start. **Crafty Friend** (Crafty Prospector) wired the field in the July 12 GII Bel Air H. at Hollywood last time out.

Royal Haven, winner of the Mar. 16 Toboggan H. at Aqueduct, ran second to Cold Execution in a July 20 Belmont handicap race last time out, but turned the tables on that rival here. The winner settled in good position early while racing along the inside and then angled out for the stretch run and grabbed the lead inside the final sixteenth. "I had a prefect trip," winning jockey Richard Migliore said. "Royal Haven can be a little difficult at the gate, but once he got out and broke well, I knew he had a great chance. Once he gets to the lead, he starts looking around and floating. I learned from my mistake; Cold Execution wasn't going to beat us again, not for \$100,000." Favored Punch Line, winner of six of his last seven starts, bobbed at the start, set a pressured pace and then tired late. DILIGENCE (Miswaki) broke in the air, moved wide to challenge on the far turn and finished well but had to settle for fourth.

Eddie Blind, head starter for Maryland Thoroughbred racing for more than 30 years, died Wednesday at the age of 90. He had been a patient at Veteran's Hospital in Havre de Grace since June 27. Born in Vancouver, British Columbia, Blind began his career in Maryland in 1938 when he was asked to come down from New York to start the Pimlico Special, a match race between Sea Biscuit and War Admiral. After serving three years in the U.S. military during World War II, he took over as Maryland's head starter in 1948 and sent off the fields for 32 consecutive Preaknesses. Overall, Blind started more than 72,000 races during his career before retiring in 1980. He is survived by his wife, Edna Mae, daughter Joan Long, sons Coleman and Frank, eight grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
