# SOUTH AMERICAN SENSATION: PACIFIC CLASSIC TO GENTLEMEN He

may not have handled the track, but South American super horse Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois) certainly handled his four challengers as he charged down the stretch to take yesterday's GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar by a comfortable 2 3/4 lengths, it was an impressive performance but far from the best he has to offer, according to jockey Gary Stevens. "The competition isn't going to like this, but you didn't get to see the real Gentlemen today," said Stevens. "He hated it out there. He never changed leads except for about 20 yards going into the far turn. He was on his left lead all the way around and he wouldn't get off it. He was never comfortable at any point in the race, and he still ran like that. This is one amazing racehorse. He's the best I've ever had anything to do with." Runaway winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in his latest effort June 29 and a game victor over Skip Away in the GI Pimlico Special in May, the five-year-old earned his third straight Grade I triumph, and his eighth victory in 10 U.S. outings. Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}), who handed Gentlemen his last defeat taking the GI Santa Anita H. in March, pressed the early pace, took over on the far turn and finished well but had to settle for second. As for the future, trainer Richard Mandella, conditioner of the top two, said the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park October 18 could be next. Gentlemen's owner, R.D. Hubbard, indicated that his awesome Argentinean has also earned himself a supplemental nomination to the GI \$4,000,000-added Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park November 8.

Beaten only once in his last eight starts and seven-fornine since shipping to the U.S., Gentlemen (Arg) pocketed his third consecutive Grade I score with a powerful exhibition at Del Mar. Allowed to settle in fourth as Crafty Friend set the pace, the 1-2 choice picked it up as Siphon (Brz) moved to the lead on the far turn, then collared his stablemate as they straightened into the stretch and strode clear. Jockey Gary Stevens said the chestnut had trouble with the racetrack, but, "When we came up even with Siphon, he got into it a little bit. Then when we got a head in front, it was all over. He's something. He had to work hard given the circumstances, and he earned it." Added trainer Richard Mandella, who was one-two in a Grade I race for the third time this year, "I could see the two of them were going to be in a big fight and it was just exciting to watch. I wasn't trying to see who was looking better or worse." Siphon, runner-up last time out to Gentlemen in the Hollywood Gold Cup in his first start since finishing second in the Dubai World Cup in April, shadowed the front-runner through three-quarters in 1:11 3/5, took a short lead at the quarter-pole and battled on bravely down the stretch. "We gave 'em a run," said his rider, Chris McCarron, "It was a horse race from the fivesixteenths to inside the eighth pole. But (Gentlemen) was just too much." RIVER KEEN (IRE) (Keen {GB}), previously undefeated on the dirt, was with the leaders for six furlongs but stopped badly and finished last. "He was in extreme distress," said jockey Kent Desormeaux. "He must have bled." PERCUTANT (GB) (Perrault {GB}) unseated Corey Nakatani during the pre-race warm-up and ran off; he was scratched by the stewards.

Winning trainer David Donk indicated that the Aug. 24 GI Arlington Million will be next for the winner. Favored INFLUENT (Ascot Knight) set a fast pace and then weakened late to finish fifth. "This is not what we wanted," said trainer Howie Tesher. "You can't run like this going this far. My idea was to let the other two go and sit behind them. As long as he comes back good, we can forget about this and start over next time."

Rated just off the pace early, Tenuous came with her run at the top of the straight and battled Majinskaya (Fr) to the wire, proving best in the final yards. Trainer Pascal Bary indicated the winner could head for the G1 Prix Vermeille over 1 1/2 miles at Longchamp September 14.
