"INDUSTRY ALLIANCE" NAMED NATIONAL THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATION The group previously known only as the "industry alliance" gained a name, a shape and additional funding as the newly christened National Thoroughbred Racing Association dominated the topics of discussion at yesterday's 45th annual Round Table Conference on Matters Pertaining to Racing, which is sponsored by the Jockey Club. In addition to announcing its official name, the NTRA released a preliminary business plan and hopes to raise \$20 million next year. Among the group's goals are the formation of centralized marketing efforts, additional television exposure and the development of interactive wagering, all of which would be done through a central office. Much of the funding, a projected \$12 million, will come from simulcasting revenues, the percentages divided equally between track and purse surcharges. In order to accomplish this, the NTRA hopes to acquire two to three percent of the net simulcasting revenue from cooperating tracks. The NTRA has already raised \$5 million, the final \$1 million of which came vesterday in a pledge from the NTA, an owners group that paved the way for the formation of the NTRA. "This is the last chance for the future of our great sport," said John Gaines, a driving force behind the NTA, in announcing the \$1 million pledge. "Ladies and gentlemen, if you don't believe in miracles you're not a realist." Gaines was one of dozens of industry leaders to pledge his support to the principles behind the NTRA. The group unveiled a list of supporters that included virtually all of the major racetracks in the nation and almost all of the major racing organizations. It was an impressive display that lent an air of optimism to the announcements. NTRA leaders know they will be trying to succeed where all others have failed in an attempt to bring factions together to advance and unify the sport, but the organization appeared yesterday to be well organized and well funded. "It will be different this time for three reasons," said D.G. Van Clief Jr, the CEO of the Thoroughbred Alliance Planning Corporation. "One, every sector of the industry is represented at the table, and that's never happened before. Two, we have adequate start-up funding, which is a departure from past attempts. Three, there is such a depth of commitment at so many levels. There has been so much time put into this that we are further along than the others were."

"I expected the going to be softer, but I can't complain, it is perfect," said Princely Heir's trainer Mark Johnston, who was winning his first Irish Group 1 race. "When Jason (Weaver) pushed Princely Heir past Hopping Higgins I was happy we would win and my horse saw out the six furlongs well. I gave Jason no instructions other than to let the horse settle into his rhythm and go where he wanted. Princely Heir is a member of the best bunch of two-year-olds I have ever had." Weaver later collected a four-day suspension for excessive use of the whip on Princely Heir.

GENTLEMEN'S PLANS UP IN THE AIR in hot

pursuit of Horse of the Year honors with Saturdav's GI Pacific Classic winner Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois), trainer Dick Mandella is keeping all options open for his handicap star. The California-based conditioner cited the Sept. 20 GI Woodward at Belmont and a race in California as a prep and even added that Gentlemen may not race again before the November 8 Breeders' Cup Classic. "Nothing else means that much right now except the Breeders' Cup," Mandella said. "We've got a lot of choices to make and will do whatever is best to get him to Nov. 8. The owner (R.D. Hubbard) has to put up \$800,000 to run him, so we're going to really concentrate on the Breeders' Cup." Gentlemen will not race in the Oct. 18 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, but Mandella indicated Pacific Classic runner-up Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}) may go in that race. If Gentlemen runs in the Woodward he would likely face Belmont and Haskell winner Touch Gold (Deputy Minister).

THIS WEEK IN RACING HISTORY...

August 12, 1943...Representatives of Suffolk Downs donated \$625,000 to the National War Fund, the single largest contribution by any sports venue in support of the war effort. Six weeks later, an additional \$10,885 was donated; the two contributions were funded by of an 18day War Charity meet.

August 13, 1919...Upset scored a win against Man o'War in the Sanford Memorial S. at Saratoga. The defeat was Big Red's only loss in 21 career starts.

August 14, 1938...Trainer Mary Hirsch became the first woman to saddle the winner of the Travers S. at Saratoga, sending out Thanksgiving for owner Anne Corning.

August 14, 1939...The record payoff for a \$2 Daily Double, \$10,772.40, lit up the tote board at Washington Park. Joy Bet and Merry Caroline produced the record.

August 15, 1972...Brigadier Gerard's 15-race winning streak was ended by **Roberto**, who captured the Benson & Hedges Gold Cup at York Racecourse by three lengths to hand the English runner his only career defeat.
