HECTOR PROTECTOR RETURNS TO EUROPE

England's National Stud at Newmarket has leased Hector Protector (Woodman) from Teruva Yoshida's Shadai Stallion station in Hokkaido, Japan, for the 1998 Northern Hemisphere season. The deal was handled jointly by the British Bloodstock Agency and The National Stud. Nine-year-old Hector Protector, a full-brother to the 1996 European champion three-year-old filly Bosra Sham, raced for his breeder, Stavros Niarchos, and was the unbeaten champion juvenile in Europe in 1991. As a three-year-old, he won the French 2000 Guineas and the G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques Le Marois before being sold to Shadai Farm. Hector Protector was leading Freshman Sire in Japan in 1995 with eight winners of 14 races and leading second-season sire in 1996 producing 31 winners of 40 races. He has produced four stakes winners from his first crop of runners, and is currently fifth on the Japanese two-year-old sires list and 11th on the overall sires list. At The National Stud, Hector Protector will be limited to 75 mares: the nomination fee and closing date for applications will be announced at a later date.

FASIG-TIPTON PREFERRED YEARLING SALE

SHOWS GAINS The 1997 Fasig-Tipton Preferred Yearling Sale, held Sunday at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York, saw 49 horses sell for a total of \$1,423,000, up 87 percent from last year's auction, when 38 hips grossed \$761,800. The 1997 average, \$29,041, showed an increase of 45 percent over last year's figure of \$20,047. The sales topper was a colt by Salt Lake--Dissa Six (Saratoga Six); consigned by Jeffrey T. Minton, agent for Ivy League Farm, the chestnut was purchased for \$100,000 by Sugar Maple Farm. The highest-priced filly, a daughter of Dr. Blum out of Playgirl Princess (Princely Native), was consigned by Kathleen Feron and attracted a bid of \$82,000 from Carl Lizza Jr.

AMERICA'S DAY WAGER CHRISTENED Organizers of America's Day At The Races have released the name of their inaugural pick-3 wager. The "Coast-to-Coast Triple" features a 10-percent takeout, the lowest ever for an exotic bet; the three legs of the pick-3 will be the Miss Woodford S. from Monmouth, the Springfield S. from Arlington International and the Del Mar Derby from Del Mar. All three races will be televised live Monday, September 1, on *espn2* from 5-5:30 p.m. EDT.



As for what's next, he remarked, "Right now, we're going to the Spinaway (August 29). She's the real deal.'

Wild Wonder (Wild Again), third in the GIII Riva Ridge S.
