3,668 CATALOGED FOR KEENELAND

SEPTEMBER Catalogs for Keeneland's September Yearling Sale will contain the pedigrees of 3,668 horses, third highest in the history of the annual auction, officials announced yesterday. The sale will span 10 days, September 8-17. Sessions start at 10 a.m. daily. Prominent sires represented include Storm Cat, Mr. Prospector, Danzig, Seattle Slew, A.P. Indy, Gulch, Seeking the Gold, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Kris S. and Nureyev.

FOOT WOES FOR SIPHON Pacific Classic runner-up **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}) is being treated for a foot problem, according to trainer Richard Mandella. "We think it's a bruised foot," Mandella said yesterday morning. "We put a poultice on it yesterday (Wednesday) and he seems better today." Mandella said plans still called for Siphon to run next in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 18, but added, "We need to get over the foot problem first."

CONCERTO JOINS MOTT STABLE GI Jim Beam S. winner **Concerto** (Chief's Crown), unraced since finishing sixth in the Preakness, has been turned over to trainer Bill Mott. The George Steinbrenner-owned colt had previously raced for conditioner John Tammaro III. "I got him (from off the farm) a couple of days ago," Mott said. "He's been galloping since July but hasn't breezed yet. He seems like he's doing fine; we might breeze him by the end of the month. I guess I might get tickets to some Yankees games now." Tammaro, who still trains some of Steinbrenner's horses said, "What can I say? You'll have to talk to Mr. Steinbrenner. I'm sure it was a business move." Steinbrenner fired jockey Carlos Marquez, Jr. after Concerto's ninth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby.

KEENELAND STAKES SCHEDULE RELEASED

Keeneland's 1997 stakes schedule has been released and features purse increases and sponsorship for the track's two Grade II races for two-year-olds. Mr. & Mrs. William S. Farish's Lane's End Farm will sponsor the GI Breeders' Futurity and Walmac International, managed by John T L Jones, Jr., will sponsor the Alcibiades. Both races are worth \$400,000, boosting stakes purses for the Oct. 4-25 meeting to a record \$2,895,000. Other highlights of the stakes schedule are the Oct. 12 \$500,000 GI Three Chimneys Spinster and the opening-day feature \$400,000 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup.

Local News, England:

Next Tuesday's G1 Juddmonte International S. over 10 furlongs 85 yards looks to be attracting only four runners, the smallest field in the race's 25-year history. But what the field lacks in quantity is more than made up by quality, headed by the leading all-time European money-earner, **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}). Facing him will be champion filly **Bosra Sham** (Woodman), Vodafone Epsom Derby hero **Benny The Dip** (Silver Hawk) and **Desert King (Ire)** (Danehill), winner of both the Lexus Irish 2000 Guineas and the Budweiser Irish Derby this season. Bookmakers Ladbrokes make Bosra Sham the even-money favorite, with Japan Cup and Dubai World Cup hero Singspiel at 2-1, Benny The Dip 5-1 and Desert King 7-1.

Rarotonga Treaty (Aus) (Geiger Counter), winner of the G1 Premier's Champion S. in July, has captured the Champion Juvenile Male title at this year's ARCSA awards in South Africa.
