AWESOME AGAIN PREPS FOR TRAVERS GII

Jim Dandy S. winner **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister) worked five furlongs in 1:02 under jockey Mike Smith yesterday morning as he continues preparations for the GI Travers S. August 23. A winner of three of his four career starts, the colt vaulted from the Hollywood Park maiden ranks to capture the 10-furlong GIC Queen's Plate at Woodbine June 29, then followed that score with an impressive effort in the Jim Dandy August 3. "I really wanted him to pick it up from the sixteenth pole through the wire and really finish up," said trainer David Hofmans, on hand for the breeze. "And he did what I hoped he would do. He absolutely loves it up here at Saratoga, and I can see how much he has developed since the Jim Dandy. He's more focused and aggressive...he has been knocking down the barn since the Jim Dandy, so this breeze will do him some good."

DUBAI WORLD CUP DATE SET The third running of the Dubai World Cup will be held Saturday, March 28, 1998 at Nad Al Sheba racetrack, it was announced yesterday. The mile-and-a-quarter event has been awarded Group One status for the first time for next year's edition. First entry for the World Cup will take place Wednesday, November 19, with a second alternative entry set for February 4. Nominations are free. Dubai World Cup entrants are also eligible for the Dubai Duty Free, to be run on the World Cup undercard.

BUICK PEGASUS TOPS MEADOWLANDS

STAKES SCHEDULE The \$1 million GII Buick Pegasus H., a nine-furlong test for three-year-olds set for Saturday, September 20, highlights the 67-race stakes program at this year's Meadowlands meet which begins September 5. The New Jersey oval will offer an additional five graded stakes, including the opening-night feature, the GIII \$100,000 Honey Bee Breeders' Cup H. for three-year-old fillies going a mile and a sixteenth. There are also 61 overnight stakes on the program. With regularly scheduled day racing on the agenda for the first time, post time at the Meadowlands this fall will be 12:45 p.m. Tuesdays through Thursdays, and 7:30 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays. The 71-day season ends December 13.

The winner, sent off as the longest price on the board, raced well off the early pace before rallying between horses at the top of the stretch and surging to the front in the final 20 yards. "We were last early, but we didn't lose contact with the field," winning jockey Chris DeCarlo said. "The longer you wait with this horse, the better it is. I was kind of glad that they backed into me because it gave me a chance to get him to relax, and then down the lane all I had to do was find room. He really came running late and there was enough time to get there."

Decorated Hero (GB) took his record to nine wins from 20 starts with his first Group victory in this event. Winner of a listed stakes at Haydock Park in June and Newbury in July 18, he reversed the form of his last start when he ran sixth in the Beeswing S. at Newcastle July 26. Unconditional Love (Ire) set the pace in the early stages of the race, with Decorated Hero and jockey Frankie Dettori poised on the heels of the leaders. With three-sixteenths of a mile to run, Dettori asked his mount to quicken, cruising to the front and going on to win comfortably. Winning trainer John Gosden was very pleased with his five-year-old, saying, "We are very fond of him. We used to call him 'Square Wheels,' as he is not the smoothest of movers. He is the lead horse for (English Derby winner) Benny The Dip and is a real house favorite--he is such a friendly and charming horse you could invite him to dinner."
