### TOUCH GOLD TO SKIP TRAVERS GI

Belmont S. and GI Buick Haskell Invitational winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) will not make his next start in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga August 23 as had been planned. Trainer David Hofmans said yesterday he was concerned about the condition of the colt's left front quarter, which he grabbed when he stumbled at the start of the Preakness in May, and with the way he has handled the surface at Saratoga in his morning gallops. "I didn't like the way the hoof looked after his gallop (Friday)," said Hofmans. "We put a bar shoe on five days before the gallop. There had been some growth and I felt good about it, but it looked like there was starting to be some pockets of infection forming." As for the track itself, the trainer said, "He hated it. I can see now why they call it the graveyard of favorites. The track is so deep and loose, a big strong horse can't get hold of it." Hofmans will instead point Touch Gold for the GI \$1 million Pegasus H. at the Meadowlands September 20. "But that is only a possibility right now," he admitted. "I'm not going to race him until I'm satisfied the foot is better." Stablemate **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister), winner of the GI Jim Dandy S. last out, will start in the Travers.

### BLACK TIE AFFAIR TO JAPAN Black Tie Affair

(Ire) (Miswaki), the 1991 Horse of the Year and Champion Older Horse, has been sold to Japan's East Stud, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. The 11-year-old, winner of the '91 Breeders' Cup Classic, was purchased for nearly \$7 million from partners Ben P. Walden Jr.'s Vinery and Jeff Sullivan. With three crops racing, Black Tie Affair's progeny have earned more than \$5.6 million; his 11 stakes winners include Formal Gold, who captured this year's GI Donn H. and finished second by a nose in the GI Whitney S. last out. Black Tie Affair stood his first six seasons at Vinery, commanding a fee of \$15,000 in 1997.

Making her graded stakes debut in quest of her fifth consecutive victory, Runup the Colors followed a rallying score in the Delaware Oaks with yet another impressive performance. Stretching out beyond a mile and a sixteenth for the first time, the dark bay stalked 3-5 Ajina through three-quarters in 1:12.22, moved to challenge at the quarter-pole and then outfinished the favorite in a prolonged drive. "I can't say I was totally confident with her, especially along the backstretch," said jockey Jerry Bailey, who tops the Saratoga rider standings with 36 wins through 22 days of the meet. "Mike (Smith) seemed to be going so easy with Ajina, and I was encouraging my filly at every pole. I knew I had to stay close, because I didn't want Ajina to open up on us. When we left the three-eighths pole, (Runup the Colors) grabbed it on her own and then I knew we would pass Ajina and win." Winning trainer Neil Howard also saddled the late-running Tomisue's Delight to be third. "What can I say? It's just a fabulous feeling," he remarked. "How often can you have two fillies that can compete in this condition?" As for the favorite, winner of the GI Mother Goose and GI Coaching Club American Oaks in her last two starts, trainer Bill Mott said, "It was pretty plain to see. We had no excuse. The other filly ran a good race. She laid off us and ran us down."

Winning for the first time in four starts this year and for only the fourth time in 12 lifetime starts, Prince Khaled Abdullah's homebred Dushyantor gained revenge on Shantou for his narrow defeat in last year's Doncaster St. Leger and eked out a very hard-fought victory over three-year-old Panama City. The runner-up tried to go wire-to-wire for the victory, but was caught close to home. Prince Khaled's racing manager Grant Pritchard-Gordon explained that tying the colt's tongue for the first time contributed to his long-awaited success. "He ran with his tongue tied down for the first time today because Henry (Cecil) thought that he had been playing about with it during his previous races," he explained. "He's come back to his best now, but, apart from Ascot in June (when he was sixth to Predappio {GB} in the G2 Hardwicke S. June 20), he has run creditably all season and it could just be that he is an autumn horse. You would have to think about the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe for him now." Panama City's trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam still has St. Leger hopes for the colt, while Shantou's trainer John Gosden was happy with his colt's run. "I'm delighted with him," he said. "It was a falsely run race--he needs a strong pace--but he's still run up to St. Leger form, as he was giving five pounds to Dushyantor." Godolphin's Hardwicke S. winner Predappio (GB) missed the race as he became cast in his box overnight.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races, and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

They weren't going to catch us even if we went around again. I knew Wayne was very high on this horse, and now I know why." "It looks he'll be one of the better two-year-olds," Lukas, who won the Sapling for the seventh time, said. "After this I'll talk with the owners, and we'll decide where we want to go.
