U.S. SIRES HIGHLIGHT TATTERSALLS HOUGHTON YEARLING SALE Thirty-five

American-based stallions will be represented in the upcoming Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale in Newmarket, England, set for September 30-October 2. Among the 351 hips catalogued are yearlings by such top sires as Danzig, Gulch, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Rahy, Riverman, Seeking the Gold, Silver Hawk and Woodman. Europe's leading sires will also have a strong contingent, with 20 by five-time champion Sadler's Wells, nine by Caerleon, eight by both Danehill and Fairy King, 11 by Rainbow Quest and nine by leading European freshman sire Zafonic. The three-day auction also features the first Sunday Silence yearling to be offered outside of Japan. "This must be amongst the most international Houghton catalogues ever compiled," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "The sires' index reads like a 'Who's Who' of world racing, combining the very best from Europe and North America, and of course the particularly exciting colt by Sunday Silence."

ISELIN HOPEFULS WORK Eclipse Award-winner Skip Away (Skip Trial) and GISW Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), the favorites for the GII Philip J. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park this Saturday, had their final preps for the 1 1/16-mile test yesterday morning. Skip Away, a distant third in the GI Whitney S. last out August 2, went a half in :46 4/5 at Monmouth. "It's what we wanted," said trainer Sonny Hine. "I'm going to get him sharp for Saturday's race." As for his effort in the Whitney, Hine commented, "Skippy throws in a flop race every now and again and I didn't even count that race in the Whitney. He made a little run at the leaders, but the track was real deep and they were running real race horse time and my horse just couldn't catch them." Formal Gold, runner-up to Will's Way by a nose in the Whitney, also breezed a half Sunday morning. "The clockers caught him in :47 flat," said trainer Bill Perry. "He galloped out in 1:01 and change, which was just fine." Skip Away has been assigned top weight of 124 pounds for the Iselin, while Formal Gold is in with 121. The two have met four times this year, with Skip Away winning the GIII Massachusetts H. and GII Suburban, and Formal Gold winning the GI Donn H. and finishing in front of his rival once again in the Whitney.

The winner's pacemaker PIPERI (IRE) (Machiavellian) went to the lead at a strong gallop with Spinning Wheel always in striking position. At the quarter-pole, Spinning Wheel and Daylami (Ire) came cruising up on the outside and soon drew away to battle down the stretch; Spinning Wheel proved to be the best in the last 100 yards, going on to a course-record setting score. Fourth in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 16 in his last outing, the winner seemed to have been freshened by the break, and trainer Jonathan Pease was well satisfied before the race that all his preparation had gone smoothly. Alain Cooper, the Niarchos family's racing manager, said, "This victory is really a big relief. After the bad race that he ran at Newbury, we were not sure if he would come back to his best for this race, but he showed us that he has freshened up since then and was back to his best form. He will probably follow the same plan as last year, which will include a run in the Prix du Moulin de Longchamp at Longchamp September 7 and then head for the Breeders' Cup Mile at Hollywood Park (November 8)." Winning Jockey Cash Asmussen was estatic after the race. "I don't understand why he ran such a bad race at Newbury," he said. "Today he felt like one of the best horses that I have ever ridden. I was just cruising on him all the time and the only real danger ever in the race was Daylami. I am hopful that he will be the first horse to give me a success in a Breeders' Cup race."

Famous Digger, an astute \$40,000 claim from trainer Richard Mandella in January, had won five-of-seven since breaking her maiden for a \$50,000 tag at Santa Anita February 26 and had put together three consecutive stakes scores coming into her first Grade I attempt. Having passed the Grade II test with a two-length victory in the San Clemente H. last out July 26, the bay was even-money to take her fourth straight and did so with a hard-fought decision. On the lead from the start, the crowd's choice was joined by import See You Soon (Fr) at the top of the stretch but turned back that challenge and had enough left to hold off the late surge of another from France, Golden Arches (Fr), for a narrow score. "I didn't want to go to the front with her, but she was so sharp I just had to let her go," said jockey Brice Blanc, who earned his first Grade I win here. "But it was okay--when she straightened out on the backstretch she took a deep breath and relaxed. When (See You Soon) came to me, I knew my filly still had something left. I knew she'd find more. Believe me, she's a nice one." Trainer Barry Abrams also picked up his first Grade I victory with his former claimer. "I just told (Blanc) to ride her--don't worry about anybody," he said. "Ride her like she's the best horse. I knew she was better than these...I said let her go to the front and if they beat us, they beat us. She's a helluva horse."


