MEADOW MONSTER TO STAND AT HILL 'N'

DALE GSW **Meadow Monster** (Meadowlake), a winner of 11 of his 24 career starts and \$496,916, will stand at Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington, Kentucky for the 1998 breeding season. The six-year-old, who was second in the Suffolk Downs Breeders' Cup H. May 31 in his lone start this year, has been bothered by foot problems but is being pointed to the Breeders' Cup. "He has been troubled by a quarter crack for half the year, but I think we're on track for the Breeders' Cup Sprint," said his trainer, Ben Perkins, Sr. The Kentucky-bred won four of his six starts in 1996, including the GII General George H. at Laurel.

This is the best all-age contest of the European season to date, with Epsom Derby winner Benny The Dip and dual Irish Classic winner Desert King taking on champion older filly Bosra Sham and the leading European all-time money-earner Singspiel. Both older horses reappear after defeats. Singspiel, first in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 6, finished only fourth in the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 26 last time he ran. Bosra Sham, winner of the G2 Prince Of Wales S. at Ascot June 17, was third in the controversial G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown July 5, but her rider Kieren Fallon was blamed for that defeat and subsequently lost the mount to Pat Eddery. Benny The Dip won the G2 Dante S. over this track and distance prior to his Epsom Derby score, then ran what may have been the best race of his life when runner-up to Pilsudski (Ire) in the Coral-Eclipse. Desert King, winner of both the Irish 2000 Guineas May 25 and Budweiser Irish Derby June 29, may be a bad traveller. He failed to fire on both previous visits to England, finishing fourth in the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Ascot June 17. Bookmakers Ladbrokes have Bosra Sham at even-money, Singspiel at 2-1, Benny The Dip at 5-1 and Desert King at 6-1.
