TEXAS YEARLING SALE WRAP-UP The Fasig-Tipton Texas Summer Yearling Sale concluded its two-day run Tuesday night at the Will Rogers Equestrian Center in Forth Worth. The session topper Tuesday was hip number 518, a colt by Bionic Prospect--Robalea Lass. The yearling, consigned by Fossil Creek Ranch, agent, brought a final bid of \$65,000 from Juvenile Farms. The highest priced filly, selling for \$53,000, was by Two Punch out of Sweet Silver. She was purchased by Donna Wormser from the consignment of S. F. Henderson. In all, 418 horses were sold for a total of \$3,480,000. The 1997 average sale price was \$8,325--up 28.7 percent from last year when 369 horses sold for a total of \$2,387,100 and an average of \$6,469.

BREEDERS' CUP WAGERING MENU RELEASED

Breeders' Cup Limited has announced a new wagering menu for the November 8 Breeders' Cup Championship at Hollywood Park. Highlighted by the new Breeders' Cup Pick 6, the menu features Pick 3 wagers for every Breeders' Cup race, as well as Superfectas on four Breeders' Cup races--the Sprint, Mile, Turf and Classic. There will be win, place and show, exacta and trifecta wagering on all seven Breeders' Cup races and on the day's three Hollywood Park stakes. Since the inaugural running of the Breeders' Cup in 1984, win bets have averaged \$20.30, exactas \$205.95 and trifectas \$1,512.60.

NUMBERS UP AT WASHINGTON YEARLING

SALE At Tuesday's Washington Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Summer Yearling Sale, 153 horses sold for a total of \$2,610,100. The 1997 average sales price was \$17,059--up 7.6 percent from the 1996 sale when 141 yearlings sold for a total of \$2,235,500 and an average of \$15,855. The median figure of \$13,000 was up 30 percent from last year's figure of \$10,000. Top price of \$140,000 was paid for hip number 128, a filly by Star de Naskra--No Extra Charge. Consigned by Northwest Farms, agent, the yearling was purchased by Dan Agnew.

Older horses again dominated their younger rivals as My Emma (GB) beat Whitewater Affair (GB) to win her second Group 1 race in seven lifetime starts and now heads for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in Paris October 5. On her only previous start this year, the filly finished third in the G2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil in France July 20. She was settled at the rear of the field while Whitewater Affair led at a fast pace from Crown Of Light (GB), who had delayed the start of the race for 15 minutes after getting loose. At the three-eighths pole, REAMS OF VERSE (Nureyev) threw down her challenge while jockey Darryl Holland brought My Emma, 10 lengths behind the leaders at the three-eighths pole, through along the rail with a perfectly timed challenge to take command close home for a clever win. Crown Of Light ran on well for third, while Reams Of Verse faded to fourth. "I was not as confident as Darryl (Holland)," said winning trainer Rae Guest. "But My Emma has a lovely turn of foot and she was helped by the pace. The faster the better for her. This was the first dream and the 'Arc' is the next." It was a first-ever Group 1 victory for Holland, who said: "I really enjoyed it - I've waited long enough. She is really suited by a fast pace. But I nearly blew it, though. I think I got to the front too soon and had to take a tug, but she quickened again and won it well. She's so game."

On his third career start, 16-1 outsider Carrowkeel (Ire) pulled off a shock victory with this defeat of G3 July S. winner Bold Fact. Carrowkeel led from the start, was headed by Bold Fact at the eighth pole and battled back with great determination to win going away at the wire. "He is entered in the Mill Reef S. at Newbury (September 20) and all the other good races later in the season," said winning trainer Barry Hills. "I think he will get seven furlongs. He was held up when he won on his debut at Windsor (May 19) and now he has won from the front, so he is very adaptable."

PEDIGREE SHORTS

Great mares get everywhere! Australian sprint star **Spartacus (Aus) (c, 4, Snippets {Aus}--Pazzihi {Aus}, by Manihi {Aus})**—who was taking his third Grade 1 when landing the G1 Manikato S. over the weekend—has a pedigree which looks unfamiliar to U.S. eyes, but there can be little doubt that much of his ability is derived from the fact that he has a double of Grey Flight 5x5. What is particularly interesting are the sources of the Grey Flight strains. Spartacus's sire Snippets has as his second dam Scampering (by a son of Grey Flight out of a mare by a son of Ambiorix II) and on the distaff side Grey Flight appears through Gray Phantom (by Ambiorix II out of Grey Flight).
