MIDSUMMER OCTETTE A field of eight threevear-old colts was entered vesterday for Saturday's 128th running of the GI Travers S. at Saratoga. The 9-5 morning-line favorite Awesome Again (Deputy Minister), victorious in the GII Jim Dandy and GIC Queen's Plate, drew post six. The colt is pinch-hitting for stable star Touch Gold, but trainer David Hofmans is confident the lightly raced colt is up to the challenge. "He has filled out even more since the Jim Dandy and he is much more aggressive," Hofmans said yesterday. "In the mornings, you can see him looking to split horses, looking to pass horses. This was the horse (owner) Mr. (Frank) Stronach felt had worlds of ability and this is the one he told me to take my time with and get to the Queen's Plate. To have won that race and the Jim Dandy and have him in position to win the Travers is far beyond our expectations. He is ahead of schedule and it is because of his talent." Trainer H. James Bond is looking for a second straight Travers win after his Will's Way upset Preakness winner Louis Quatorze and threeyear-old champion Skip Away to win the 1996 edition of the race. This year, he will be represented by Behrens (Pleasant Colony) who suffered the lone defeat of his four-race career when fourth as the favorite in the Jim Dandy. "It would be a great honor to win the Travers back-to-back, but then I think it is a great honor just to run in the Travers," Bond said. As for his colt, Bond exuded confidence, "I think he is as good a three-yearold as there is this year." Behrens is the 5-2 second choice on the morning line. Also looking to avenge a loss to Awesome Again is Cryptocloser (Cryptoclearance). Awesome Again bested that rival by 31/2 lengths when the two Canadian-breds squared off in the Queen's Plate. With Awesome Again absent, Cryptocloser rebounded to capture the second leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, the July 27 Prince of Wales S. The 8-1 fourth choice will break from post position seven in this affair. The Travers will be broadcast live on ESPN from 4:30-5:30 p.m. EDT with a scheduled 5:10 post.
