"DEPUTY" TAKES COMMAND IN

TRAVERS Giving his sire Deputy Minister yet another Grade I winner, **Deputy Commander** flew in from California and then flew down the stretch at Saratoga to take yesterday's GI \$750,000 Travers by a nose. Making his first start since running second to Free House in the GII Swaps S. July 20, the dark bay colt proved fit for his first test at a mile-and-a-quarter, sitting just off the fractions of **Affirmed Success** (Affirmed) early and sweeping to the lead on the far turn. He was joined by **Behrens** (Pleasant Colony) at the top of the stretch and those two battled down to the wire; it took the photo finish camera to separate them. "There was a question of whether this horse could go a mile and a quarter, but everyone has that question," said trainer Wally Dollase. "My horse got passed in the stretch and came on again. He showed a lot of heart and determination. This is a great thrill for me to be a part of this. I am more excited about this than the Breeders' Cup, because it was such a close race." It was an emotional moment for winning jockey Chris McCarron, whose mother passed away Tuesday at the age of 75. "When I got the news last Tuesday night, I was a little selfish," said McCarron. "I called home and put some of the burden on my family, and they all gave me their blessing (to ride in the Travers). They told me if my mother has anything to do with this, she'll give a little boost. Sure enough, I could feel her presence." The 7-5 favorite **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister), winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. last out, closed to second at the quarter-pole, but ran out of gas and had to settle for third, seven lengths behind the runner-up. "I didn't really have a good trip," said his jockey, Mike Smith. "We were stuck wide the whole way and it was too much to overcome. That's racing, though." *Travers Stakes Result, page 2*

NUREYEV FILLY TOPS DEAUVILLE'S FIRST SESSION

Saturday evening's opening session of the 1997 Deauville Yearling Sale saw 51 yearlings sell for a gross of \$6,492,772 and an average of \$127,309. The session's highest price of \$452,233 was paid by Françoise DuPuis, agent for Wayne Hughes, for an American-bred bay filly by Nureyev--Irish Order (Irish River {Fr}). Consigned by Haras du Mezeray, the filly is a half-sister to GIII Golden Gate H. winner Irish Wings (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}). The six-day auction runs through Aug. 28.

Formal Gold sprinted straight to the lead, set quick fractions of :22 4/5, :45 2/5, 1:09, 1:33 2/5 and 1:40 1/5 while alone on the front end and was hand-ridden to an easy victory. He smashed the old track record of 1:41 flat set by Skipper Bill on June 27, 1956. "He won't get beat again," predicted winning owner John Murphy. "I told (trainer) Bill (Perry) I'm tying a \$100 bill onto (Formal Gold's) tail, and whoever can catch up with him can have it." Perry added, "This is the best horse I've ever trained. If he's in good shape we'll probably go to the Woodward (at Belmont Sept. 20) and maybe the Jockey Club Gold Cup (at Belmont Oct. 18). Obviously the Breeders' Cup (Classic at Hollywood Nov. 8) is in the back of my mind, but for me to go back to California, I'd want to be there a few weeks earlier and train over the surface." Favored Skip Away trailed the four-horse field early then closed ground to pass Distorted Humor and FOOLISH POLE (Polish Numbers), but was clearly second best. "(Formal Gold) was a monster," said Skip Away's trainer Sonny Hine. "We did all we could. But we'll get him the next time at Belmont."

Deputy Commander had campaigned on the West Coast recently, wiring the field in the GIII Affirmed H. June 15 and most recently finishing second to Free House in the GII Swaps S. July 20. Ridden for the first time here by Chris McCarron, the bettors' third choice tracked pacesetters AFFIRMED SUCCESS (Affirmed) and TWIN SPIRES (Storm Cat) early, accelerated to the front at the quarter-pole and prevailed by the slimmest of margins after a thrilling stretch duel with Behrens. 7-5 favorite Awesome Again, winner of his last three starts including the GII Jim Dandy Aug. 3, rated in mid-pack in the early going, challenged Deputy Commander for the lead at the top of the stretch then tired to be third.

Tale of the Cat exploded onto the racing scene with an 11 1/2-length victory in his debut May 26, then followed that up with a 4 1/4-length tally in a June 21 allowance and a fourth-place finish last time out in the Aug. 3 GI Haskell. Making his first start away from his Monmouth Park home here as the 8-5 chalk, he was hustled along on the inside to contest blazing early fractions of :21 3/5 and :43 2/5, then while his fellow frontrunners tired, he simply pulled away from the field for an impressive triumph. "He's a real push-button little horse," winning jockey Julie Krone said. "He's definitely something else. When I hit the quarter pole, I knew we must have been flying. I asked him to slow up and to go easy. And then when I asked him to, he took off." Winning trainer John Forbes said Tale of the Cat will run next in either the \$150,000 Jerome H. at Belmont or the \$1 million Pegasus S. at the Meadowlands, both Sept. 20. "I'll always wonder about the Travers, but I didn't want to come out of a race today and not be able to go forward," Forbes said. "The question is how far can he go? I'll leave here wondering if he could have gotten the distance in the Travers."

Among Men's trainer Michael Stoute admitted, "We got lucky there. I was disappointed with his performance. He doesn't seem to handle the track."

NYRA EXTENSION BECOMES LAW New York Governor George Pataki yesterday signed into law legislation that extends the New York Racing Association's franchise to run Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga race-tracks. The bill will extend the franchise for seven years, to December 31, 2007; it will also guarantee that the first \$2 million in annual profits generated by NYRA will be used exclusively to increase purses. In return for the Governor's signature, the State Senate will pass Pataki's chapter amendment to the bill which will improve oversight and accountability of NYRA. The amendment gives the Governor five additional appointments to the NYRA Board of Trustees, requires annual outside financial and management audits, increases the New York State Racing and Wagering Board's powers and stiffens bidding rules by requiring open competitive bids for contracts over \$100,000. "With my chapter amendment already passed by the State Assembly, this legislation will ensure New York retains its place as a leader in the racing industry as we work cooperatively with NYRA to ensure that its operations meet the highest possible standards," said Pataki.
