PAT DAY PILOTS 7,000TH WINNER Pat Day yesterday became one of only five jockeys in American racing history to ride 7,000 winners when he guided even-money **Bay Harbor** (Forty Niner) to a one-length victory in the second race at Saratoga Racecourse. Day joins the exceptional company of Bill Shoemaker, Laffit Pincay Jr., Dave Gall and Angel Cordero Jr. "It's a small and elite group and I'm honored to be a part of it," said Day, 43. "Thank God for keeping me safe and sound and allowing me to achieve this. This is special anywhere, but it is extremely special to have gotten 7,000 at Saratoga with Mr. Lukas. I want to thank everyone involved with the 7,000 winners--horses, owners, trainers and grooms." A member of the Hall of Fame and a four-time Eclipse Award winner, Day rode his first winner 24 years ago at Prescott Downs in Arizona, booting home Forblunged July 29, 1973. The purse for that claiming event was \$631. He has since won eight Breeders' Cup races and eight Triple Crown races.

RECORD START FOR OBS AUGUST YEARLING

SALE With a colt by Honor Grades leading the way, the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's August Yearling Sale got off to a record start with its Select Session yesterday. The 139 Selected yearlings grossed a record \$5,457,000. The Selected average was \$39,259, another record and up 12.4 percent from 1996 when 106 yearlings brought \$3,704,000 for an average of \$34,943. The 1997 median of \$31,000 also broke last year's mark of \$30,000, while buy backs dropped sharply, from 32 percent in 1996 to 21.9 percent this year. Also featured on opening day, the Mockingbird Farm yearling consignment saw 54 horses bring \$1,477,700, down from last year's gross of \$2,255,900; the average of \$27,365 was down 6.5 percent from the '96 figure of \$29,297, while the median was down from \$22,000 in '96 to \$20,000 this year. The Select Session's topper was a colt by Honor Grades, sire of Mid-America Triple winner Honor Glide. Consigned by Brylynn Farm, Inc., the chestnut is out of a full sister to Holy Bull and is a half-brother to multiple stakes-winner and multiple graded stakes-placed Regal Brek (Regal and Royal); he was purchased for \$165,000 by James Ventura. Said OBS President Tom Chiota, "The market for quality yearlings is strong, and we were able to meet the demand. It's nice to break our own records, but it's especially gratifying to see the buy-back percentage drop so sharply." The three-day OBS Open Yearling Sale begins today at 10 a.m.

Making her first start since taking the GII Pucker Up S. at Arlington July 6 and looking for her fourth win in five career grass starts, highweight Witchful Thinking sat just off the pace to the stretch, took over inside the eighth pole and held off the late bid of Miss Huff 'n' Puff. "She's usually speed, but there was so much speed today we were concerned," said trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "Shane (Sellers) made the right decision to drop off the pace. The last eighth of a mile really counts when carrying nine pounds more than the rest. She has more determination than any horse I've trained. She's got a heart like a lion." The runner-up, winner of the off-the-turf Gill Miss Grillo S. at two, made her turf debut last time out and wired the field in a one-mile Saratoga allowance test. Trying two turns for the first time here, she was with the pace early, dropped back on the final bend, then came again to get second. "She came off the bridle (on the far turn)," said trainer Rick Violette Jr. "It looked like she got lost out there. The lack of experience around two turns cost her." The winner will make her next start in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Invitational Cup at Keeneland October 4; the runner-up will point for the GII Rare Perfume S. at Belmont September 13.

GREEN DESERT FILLY TOPS THIRD DAY AT

DEAUVILLE A daughter of Green Desert out of Shining Eyes (Mr. Prospector) brought a bid of 1,000,000 francs (\$161,510) to top yesterday's third session of the L'Agence Francaise Deauville Yearling Sale in Deauville, France. Consigned by Neustrian Associates, agent for Haras du Buff, the filly was purchased by Rigby Bloodstock Ltd. Agency. She is out of a half-sister to Japanese champion miler Hishi Akebono (Woodman). A total of 110 yearlings sold for \$5,139,304 Monday for an average of \$46,720. The six-day auction continues through Thursday.

Starting September 6, the first Saturday of the Belmont Park fall meet, the New York Racing Association will give racing fans the chance to compete for cash prizes of up to \$5,000 in the new Fantasy Horse Racing contest. Fans will select a maximum total of 10 horses in races four through 10, and choose one of 10 pre-determined two-person jockey teams for their stables. Entries are free, with a maximum of two per person. Horses and jockeys will receive 10 points for a win, six points for a second-place finish and three points for a third-place finish. The contestant whose stable accumulates the most points will win \$1,000. The contest will be held during every Saturday of the fall season; at the end of the meet, the contestant who has made an entry every Saturday and has picked up the most points overall will receive \$5,000, with \$2,000 for the runner-up and \$1,000 to the fan who finishes third.
