**MY FLAG RETIRED** My Flag (Easy Goer), coming off yet another poor performance, a last-place finish in last Friday's GI John A. Morris H., has been retired and will be bred to Storm Cat in 1998. The winner of the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, My Flag was not herself this year. She was 0-for-4 and finished sixth in each of her three final starts, with the Morris being her worst performance yet. "I have no idea what happened to her," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "It seemed like everything was fine. She just wouldn't go over there and try." Among My Flag's six career wins were victories in the GI Ashland S., GI Coaching Club American Oaks and GI Gazelle H.--all in 1996. In her 20-race career, she earned \$1,557,057.

**BAY MEADOWS OPENS TODAY** Bay Meadows opens its 1997 fall meet tonight with a first post time at 6:45 p.m. The 63-day Thoroughbred meeting runs through November 16 and the standard racing week is Wednesday through Sunday. There will be special Monday racing cards on September 1 and 8, October 13 and November 3, and a Tuesday program on November 11. With the exception of Fridays, when post time is 6:45 p.m. throughout the meeting, post time will be 1:45 p.m. daily until September 28 and 12:45 p.m. from October 1 through November 16. Thirty stakes races worth more than \$2.2 million will be presented at the fall meeting. Two \$200,000 events highlight the stakes schedule--the Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint on Sept. 13 and the GIII Bay Meadows H. Sept. 20.

**SAINTLY NAMED AUSTRALIAN HORSE OF THE YEAR** Cox Plate and Melbourne Cup hero Sainly (Aus) (Sky Chase {NZ}) was named the 1996-97 Australian Horse Of The Year. The four-year-old chestnut gelding polled 128 out of the total of 159 votes for the award, which is conducted by the Australian Racing Writers' Association in conjunction with the major race clubs. The 1995-96 Horse Of The Year Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) finished second in the balloting this year with 25 votes. In a sensational spring campaign, Sainly won both the Cox Plate, defeating Octagonal, and the Melbourne Cup within a two-week period and added the G1 C. F. Orr S. in February. After that race, the colt suffered a serious flexor tendon injury in training, which sidelined him for the rest of the season. He is currently being prepared for a return to racing.

**OBS SALES RESULTS** The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company concluded its four-day August Yearling Sale Thursday in Ocala, Florida, with a third Open session that again showed gains over last year's corresponding session. The session's top-priced horse was **Merkaban**, a colt by Houston--Counting Moonbeams, by Private Account. Consigned by Stoneriggs Farm, agent, and sold as hip number 853, the yearling brought a final bid of \$49,000 from Eisaman Equine. During the session, 186 horses grossed \$1,842,400, compared to the \$1,329,000 aggregate when 188 horses sold last year. The \$9,905 average was up 40 percent from the 1996 figure of \$7,069. The median price of \$7,350 rose 47 percent from \$5,000 last year. Overall, the three Open sessions grossed \$6,328,300 from the sale of 615 horses. The average price increased 30.5 percent from \$7,884 last year to \$10,290 in 1997. The median price during the three open sessions was \$7,500, an increase of 36.3 percent from the 1996 median price of \$5,500.

**DEAUVILLE WRAP UP** At yesterday's sixth and final session of the Agence Francaise August Yearling Sale in Deauville, France, 70 horses sold for a total of \$1,344,585 and an average of \$19,487. The session topper, selling for \$129,209, was hip number 484. The filly, by Fabulous Dancer--Pride of Baino, by Secretariat, was consigned by Haras du Quesnay and purchased by Horse France. During all six sessions, 383 yearlings sold for a total of \$19,689,413 and an average of \$53,071.

**MELBOURNE CUP DOPING CASE REOPENED**

Australian police may reopen investigations into the doping of the favorite for the 1969 Melbourne Cup, Big Philou, after the horse's former groom, Les Lewis confessed in a newspaper interview to drugging the horse. Now aged 59 and reportedly suffering from cancer, Lewis denied responsibility for 28 years but, saying that he did not want to take his secret to the grave, yesterday admitted that he had been paid \$7,400 by a prominent Sydney racing figure to dope two horses in Australia's greatest race. Lewis alleges he was paid to drug the Bart Cummings-trained Big Philou, who arrived at the course in a sick and distressed state and had to be withdrawn from the race at the last minute, and the 2-1 race favorite Tails, who ran and finished fifth. Traces of the purgative drug danthron were found in urine samples taken from Big Philou and in droppings taken from his box at Cummings's stable. Details of Lewis's confession have been passed to the Victoria Police racing squad, as well as the name of the man who is alleged to have paid him. That individual is said to be still alive. Jockey Roy Higgins, who was due to partner Big Philou in the Melbourne Cup, said it had been generally accepted that Lewis, who served a jail term for another doping offense, was the culprit, although he was acquitted of the charge by a jury in 1970.

**MECKE TO OCALA STUD FARM** MGISW Mecke (Maudlin) will stand the 1998 breeding season at J. Michael O'Farrell, Jr.'s Ocala Stud Farm. The five-year-old bay will stand for \$7,500 live foal. Mecke retired in February after a 40-race career in which he won 12 times for earnings of \$2,460,280. He earned Grade I wins in the Arlington Million and Early Times Turf Classic on the turf and in the Isle of Capri Super Derby on dirt. His last race was a third-place finish to Formal Gold and Skip Away in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park. Mecke stood an abbreviated '97 season at Farnsworth Farms in Ocala, Florida.

"He developed an abscess in his foot," trainer Ken McPeck explained of the five-year-old's extended absence. "Then he strained the ligament behind his knee, probably from trying to protect his foot. He didn't have surgery, but this was something that we figured would take between 30 and 90 days to make right. He missed 45 days of training." McPeck said Tejano Run will start next in the GIII Turfway Championship Sept. 27 and future plans could include the Breeders' Cup.

**Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) worked five furlongs Tuesday in 1:01 3/5 and will start in Monday's GI Forego H...Also pointing towards the Forego, **Diligence** (Miswaki) worked five furlongs Monday in 1:06 4/5 over the Oklahoma Training Track.

The winner trailed the field of six early before advancing around the far turn to take the lead in the stretch and drew away easily in the lane. "This horse we knew liked the distance and the course," winning jockey Jean-Luc Samyn said. "There were a lot of scratches (six), and we weren't sure who would go to the lead. But Phil (winning trainer Johnson) told me to let the filly do whatever she wanted; not to force her back or rush her up. He knew she could go this far." Phil Johnson indicated that the winner could run back in the Nov. 2 GI Long Island H. at Aqueduct and then try the Dec. 27 GI La Prevoyante H. at Calder. The 3-5 favorite **CYMBALA** (Fr) (Assert {Ire}), who pulled up in the stretch, broke both sesamoid bones in her left front leg and was vanned off the track.
