INAUGURAL "AMERICA'S DAY AT THE RACES" SET FOR MONDAY The first-ever

"America's Day at the Races" will be held this Monday, September 1, at 21 racetracks across the United States. The event, put together by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, will promote Labor Day as the holiday Americans celebrate at the races. Participating tracks will offer promotions such as free admission: autograph sessions with the jockeys; T-shirt, cap, tote bag, poster and goggle giveaways; "Name the Yearling" contests: educational displays: and Monmouth's drawing for a trip for two to the Breeders' Cup at Hollywood Park November 8. One of the biggest attractions will be Del Mar's parade of equine stars, headed by Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm (Silver Buck); the parade will be held after the sixth race. The highlight of "America's Day" will be the Coast-to-Coast Triple, a Pick 3 wager on the Springfield S. at Arlington International, Miss Woodford S. at Monmouth Park and Gll Del Mar Derby, The Triple, a \$1 minimum bet, features a special take-out rate of only 10 percent. The three races will be televised on espn2 from 5-5:30 p.m. EDT; the broadcast is sponsored by The Blood-Horse. News cont p.3

Countess Diana broke her maiden at first asking in a June 6 Pimlico maiden race, then shipped to Churchill and finished second as the 8-5 favorite in the June 28 GIII Debutante S. Traveling north to Saratoga for her third start, the bay stretched out to six furlongs and wired the field for a two-length victory in the July 23 Gll Schuvlerville S, last time out. Bet down to 4-5 off the effort, the homebred set the pace while under pressure from the 9-5 second choice, GII Adirondack S. winner SALTY PERFUME (Salt Lake), but put that rival away at the top of the stretch and cruised clear to win as much the best. "She's a freakish kind of horse," jockey Shane Sellers said. "She's quick and she does it so easy. She did it so comfortable, like she always does. Down the stretch I just chirped at her and she fired. She's a lot faster than she shows. She makes my job so easy. I just sit on her and make sure I don't press the button too soon." Salty Perfume tired to be last. "There was no excuse today," said her jockey, Pat Day. "We were tracking the winner on the backstretch and on the turn and when my filly changed leads, she gave me nothing and went limp. I expected much better than this."


