NOTHING UP HIS SLEEVE: FAVORITE TRICK MAKES MAGIC IN HOPEFUL He

doesn't need smoke and mirrors to dazzle his rivals. Undefeated Favorite Trick (Phone Trick) is just better than the rest. Looking for his sixth straight win, the dark bay was bet down to 2-5 in yesterday's GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Racecourse and moved one step closer to an Eclipse Award with a rallying 1 1/2-length victory. "He's a freak of a colt," said trainer Pat Byrne, who went 14-for-17 at Churchill Downs before shipping to Saratoga and taking five of the prestigious meet's six two-year-old stakes. "He's the best in the country, no doubts." Jockey Pat Day settled the Joseph LaCombe colorbearer in fourth through a half in :45.02, guided him four-wide around the leaders on the far turn and rode him out to the wire to easily outfinish runner-up K.O. Punch (Two Punch). "It looks like we had another easy trip," said Day. "I was looking around (in the stretch), because Favorite Trick has the tendency to throw his ears up. I didn't think anyone was going to catch us, but I just wanted to make sure. As you could see when we hit the wire, his ears were straight up." Favorite Trick adds the Hopeful to odds-on scores in the GIII Bashford Manor and GII Saratoga Special. As for his fall campaign, Byrne said, "His first two-turn race will be the Breeders' Futurity (Keeneland, October 18), then the Breeders' Cup at Hollywood (November 8)."

Making his Grade I debut off a handy victory over a muddy track in the GII Saratoga Special, Favorite Trick was the overwhelming choice and lived up to the odds with another impressive win. The Kentucky-bred stalked the pace to the final turn, swept past the front-runners to put a head in front as they straightened into the stretch and drew clear under a Pat Day hand ride. Day credited trainer Pat Byrne with the colt's success. "Pat is a tremendous horseman," said Day. "He communicates with his horses. He keeps his horses happy--he's the best going." Favorite Trick showed his appreciation by pocketing his sixth straight; it was his fifth win in stakes company and his third in a graded event. Runnerup K.O. Punch, unbeaten in three starts in California, was third after a rough start in the Saratoga Special. He pressed pacesetter HITECH (Technology) through the early fractions, tried to match strides with Favorite Trick as they moved into the stretch and ran on gamely to the wire to be easily second best. "My horse ran great and I'm real proud of his performance," said his jockey, Joe Bravo. "He exploded when I called on him, but being pressured the whole way was tough for him." Trainer D. wayne Lukas agreed with Bravo's assessment. "He was pressured by Hitech, which compromised our chances of staying with the winner," he said. "At no point did he get a breather. I am very pleased." The top two will now ship to Belmont Park, with winner Favorite Trick pointing for the mile-and-a-sixteenth GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland October 18.
