## COLONIAL DOWNS OPENS TODAY For the first time in 150 years. Thereughbred racing returns to

first time in 150 years, Thoroughbred racing returns to the state of Virginia when Colonial Downs opens for its inaugural meeting this afternoon. Located between Richmond and Williamsburg in New Kent County, the sport's newest showcase features a five-level colonial brick grandstand which seats 6,000, stabling for more than 750 horses, a 1 1/4-mile dirt track and a 1 1/8mile turf course. The turf, at 180 feet the widest course in the country, is expected to be ready for racing during the second half of the track's 30-day season. A total of 85 horses were entered for the 10-race opening-day card, which includes the Daniel G. Van Clief S. and New Kent S. It was estimated that 75 percent of the entries had been based in Maryland, which will be dark during the Colonial Downs meet. Daily purse distribution is projected to average \$167,000 for the inaugural season. The track will offer live racing Wednesdays through Sundays, with first post at 1 p.m. weekends, 3 p.m. Wednesdays and Thursdays and 6 p.m. Fridays. Gates open at 10 a.m. today; a ribbon-cutting ceremony is set for 12:50 p.m. and the track's very first race will break from the starting gate at 1 p.m. Colonial Downs will race through October 12. The track's first-ever harness meet is scheduled to begin next April.

PLANS SET FOR BYRNE TRIO Trainer Pat Byrne vesterday mapped out a fall campaign for GI Spinaway winner Countess Diana (Deerhound), GI Hopeful victor Favorite Trick (Phone Trick) and GIII Sanford S. winner Polished Brass (Dixie Brass), who between them accounted for five of the six juvenile stakes at Saratoga this summer. All three will ship to Belmont Park, but Countess Diana will get a short break before making her next start in the GII Walmac International Alcibiades at Keeneland October 11 and Favorite Trick will make his next appearance in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at that track October 18. Polished Brass will remain in New York and point for the GI Futurity at Belmont September 21. As for ending the Saratoga meet with backto-back Grade I wins, Byrne said, "This last weekend was very special. We don't have the depth with our two-year-olds that some others have, but the three we have are really good horses. They stayed healthy and made the stakes we pointed for. You don't plan to have meets like this. You don't go in dreaming, you just go with the flow...and hope things work out. You don't stop to think about it, but when the dust settles you can reflect on a great meet."

A winner in three of her last four outings, Radu Cool had taken three non-graded events but had to settle for third in the GII A Gleam H. when she took the step up three starts back at Hollywood. Undefeated over the Del Mar main track, the chestnut tried her luck in the graded ranks once again here but this time made the grade. Forced to race on the far outside early, she closed from fourth to take the lead at the top of the stretch and dug down for the drive to take the photo from longshot Supercilious. "She loves Del Mar," said trainer John Shirreffs. "She comes down here and she eats better and she trains better. I knew she was going to run her race." Jockey Chris McCarron was winning the Chula Vista for the fourth year in a row. "With my horse and her tactical style, I could live with being parked out there two wide," said McCarron. "But today I had to live with being pushed five or six wide. I didn't know if my mare was enough horse to deal with that, but my fears turned out to be unfounded. She's as game as Dick Tracy. No, she's a mare--make that game as Jane Tracy." As for the future, Shirreffs said," We'll be looking at the Breeders' Cup (November 8, Hollywood Park), but I don't know whether I'll run again before that. She runs well fresh." Favored TODA UNA DAMA (ARG) (Cipayo {Arg}), riding a three-race winning streak against allowance company coming into this race, pressed the pace but faded late to finish last. "She bled through the nostrils," said her jockey, Alex Solis. "At the quarter pole I thought we were going to win it. But all of a sudden she just folded up. She had a reason."

Relishing the soft ground, the consistent and deserving Taipan (Ire) scored for the first time in four starts this year. With the track cut up by the weekend's racing, the field raced on the extreme outside of the course; Lord Of Men (GB) led early from Taipan (Ire) and Camporese (Ire). On the turn, all three were abreast, but spread right across the track. Taipan guickened well and hit the front at the guarter-pole, running on gamely for the victory over a determined Camporese. Winning trainer John Dunlop said, "He's a really nice horse and the key to him is the soft ground, which he found for the first time this year. He's the first foal of Alidiva and he has now made up some ground on his more famous brother and sister (Ali-Royal {Ire} and Sleepytime {Ire}). His form always looked solid and he deserved to win a good race. One of his obvious targets is the (G1) Preis Von Europa in Germany (Cologne, Sept. 28) and he might go for one of the Group One races in Italy at the end of the season." Favorite Lord Of Men was finally beaten after six straight wins and his trainer John Gosden said, "He simply ran out of stamina. This was his first start over the trip; going wide all the way was too much of a test for him and he was off the bridle at the turn. It was also too gluey for him. 
