**BRITISH RACING CANCELLED FOR PRINCESS DIANA'S FUNERAL** As a sign of respect for Diana, Princess of Wales, all scheduled race meetings in Britain have been cancelled this Saturday, the day of her funeral at Westminster Abbey in London. The British Horseracing Board made the decision Monday to cancel the scheduled meetings at Epsom, Stratford, Thirsk, Wolverhampton and Haydock Park, where the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup was due to be run. The BHB's Chairman Lord Wakeham said, "It would be inappropriate to race on a day when the nation is in mourning." The Haydock Park Sprint Cup may be rescheduled for next week's Doncaster St. Leger meeting.

**SWAIN TOPS MELBOURNE CUP WEIGHTS** Godolphin's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan) has been allotted top weight of 139 pounds for the Foster's Melbourne Cup at Flemington, Australia this November 4. It is the highest weight allotted since Galilee was assigned 141 pounds in 1968. Other horses weighted include Godolphin's **Classic Cliche (Ire)** (Salse), 133 pounds; Sheikh Mohammed's 1996 Doncaster St Leger winner **Shantou (Alleged)**, 131; **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy), 128; **Double Trigger (Ire)** (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), 130; and **Double Eclipse (Ire)** (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), 126. Last year's impressive winner, Australian Horse of the Year **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}), will miss this November's running; the top-weighted Australian-trained entrant is **Filante (NZ)** (Star Way {GB}) at 128 pounds.

The consistent Anet, first or second in his last six outings including a runner-up performance to Touch Gold in the \$1 million Buick Haskell Aug. 3, extended that streak here. Making only his second start on the turf after finishing seventh in his initial grass outing at Santa Anita Feb. 28, the Florida-bred responded by sprinting straight to the lead, setting slow fractions of :24 4/5, :49 1/5 and 1:13 on the front end then cruising along to take his first graded stakes by a length. "I just hate to pass up a Derby, whether it's on grass or dirt," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "This sets him up perfectly for the (\$1 million Buick) Pegasus (at the Meadowlands Sept. 20)."

Winless since taking a \$50,000 claimer at Monmouth Park July 2, 1996, Score A Birdie had been on the board in four of eight starts this year, most recently running third in the GIII Philadelphia Breeders' Cup H. August 3 and second in a Monmouth allowance August 16. Given little chance against graded stakes horses, the bay was the dark horse in this field but closed from near the back of the pack to catch Canadian Victor Cooley in the final yards. "He'd been knocking on the door going three-quarters so I figured seven-eighths would be good for him," said winning owner Joseph Imbesi. "I knew he had a chance because he was training so well. He's a wonderful accommodating horse and whatever you ask of him, he does." The six-year-old will make his next start in the GI Vosburgh at Belmont Park September 27. DILIGENCE (Miswaki), the 2-1 favorite, led through a half in :45.76 but faded badly and finished last. It was his first off-the-board finish at the distance.

Frisk Me Now has emerged as one of this year's leading three-year-olds with victories in the GII Hutcheson Feb. 2 (at 105-1 odds), the GIII Flamingo S. April 5 and the GII Ohio Derby June 22. Most recently fifth in the \$1 million Buick Haskell at Monmouth Aug. 3, the Florida-bred proved he was the class of this Pennsylvania Derby field, stalking pacesetter FRENCH REALITY (Proper Reality) through early fractions of :22 4/5 and :47, taking command after a half-mile and drawing off under a hand ride for a commanding 8 3/4-length triumph. Trainer Bob Durso and his wife, Carol Dender, purchased Frisk Me Now as a two-year-old at a private sale for \$18,000. "I feel this race helped his confidence," Durso said. "He actually ran a better race in the Ohio Derby. But I was happy today, since he really didn't have any pressure. We expect to run him in the (\$1 million Buick) Pegasus (at the Meadowlands Sept. 20) and that will probably be his last race this year."

Veteran runner Elated Guy, who had won or placed in 18 stakes coming into this event, had not been successful as of late, going winless in his last 12 trips to the post. His most recent victory came 13 starts back in the Bunty Lawless S. (GIIC) in October, 1995, which at the time was his third straight triumph. Respected at 2-1 odds here despite his recent misfortunes, Elated Guy pushed his career earnings over the \$900,000 mark, closing from off-the-pace for a handy victory.

South Salem raced mainly in England at ages two and three, with his best performance being a third-place finish in the G3 Coventry S. at Ascot in June, 1995. The bay colt shipped to the U.S. for a bid at last year's Belmont S., in which he was eased. Rested for 10 months following that start, South Salem resurfaced at Aqueduct this past April, finishing sixth in a dirt allowance. In four starts since--all on the grass--he has shown distinct improvement, most recently finishing second in a 1 1/2-mile Saratoga turf allowance Aug. 8. Sent off the favorite here to win his first graded stakes, he pressed the pace early, took the lead on the final turn and gamely fought off a late challenge from Lafitte the Pirate to prevail by a nose. "This was very nice, but I'd still like to give back the nose loss in the Travers," said South Salem's trainer H. James Bond, whose Behrens was defeated by the slimmest of margins by Deputy Commander in the Aug. 23 "Midsummer Derby."

The Kentucky-bred was relocated to the U.S. this past spring and had fared poorly in three Stateside starts--finishing seventh in both the GIII Comely April 19 and Nassau County S. May 14 and eighth in her turf debut in a Saratoga allowance July 23. Dismissed at 32-1 odds here, she found new life on the yielding course, rallying from the back of the pack to win by 3 1/2 lengths going away.
