# BOSTON HARBOR'S STUD FEE ANNOUNCED

The 1996 Two-Year-Old Champion **Boston Harbor** (Capote) has returned to his owner and breeder's Overbrook Farm in Lexington, Kentucky where he will enter stud in 1998. His stud fee will be \$25,000 live foal. The three-year-old colt captured last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but raced only once in 1997 finishing fourth in the February 2 Santa Catalina S. He suffered a condylar fracture of his left foreleg in a workout a few weeks later and never returned to training. He was officially retired in July. Boston Harbor raced eight times, with six victories and earnings of \$1,934,605.

CANADIAN BREEDERS SALES RESULTS The sales topper at Tuesday night's Canadian Breeders Select Yearling Sale in Ontario was hip number 39, a dark bay colt by West By West--Feather Necklace, by Waquoit. Consigned by Woodlands (Gail Wood), agent for Haras du Chevrillard, the yearling brought a final bid of \$144,425 from Crystal River Bloodstock. In all, 131 horses sold for a total of \$3,283,868 and an average of \$25,068. The average jumped 38.7 percent from last year's corresponding figure when 122 horses sold for a total of \$2,186,236 and an average of \$18,068.

DANZIG CONNECTION TO RELOCATE The 1986 GI Belmont S. winner Danzig Connection (Danzig), sire of last year's G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup winner Iktamal, is to stand at Collin Stud at Stetchworth near Newmarket, England for the 1998 breeding season. Owned by an Anglo-Australian partnership, the 14-year-old stallion is presently standing at Lakewood Stud at Wellington in South Australia and he will 'shuttle' between Collin Stud and Lakewood next year. Collin Stud manager Robin Sharp said, "Danzig Connection has a tremendous strike rate of more than 80 percent with his European runners and an overall strike rate of 75 percent winners to starters. In addition to Iktamal, he has also sired the Mill Reef S. winner Polish Laughter and the multiple Group winner and multiple Classic-placed Star Of Gdansk here in Europe. We are very pleased to be standing him here." Danzig Connection's 1998 stud fee has not been announced.

#### PEDIGREE SHORTS

Two stallions who began their careers in Japan, Hector Protector and Dr Devious, will be available to breeders in Europe in 1998, Hector Protector at the English National Stud and Dr Devious standing under the Coolmore banner in Ireland (as he did this year). The pair have something in common in that they go back in tailfemale line to daughters of Northern Dancer but are otherwise free of that strain. Hector Protector has already sired at least half a dozen Japanese stakes winners out of mares carrying son strains of Northern Dancer and on Sunday, Dr Devious was represented by his first graded stakes when Takeichi Kento (Jpn) (c, 2, Dr Devious {Ire}--Shadai Bishop {Jpn}, by Northern Taste) took the G3-Jpn Kokura Sansai S. Out of a mare by a son of Northern Dancer, Takeichi Kento has that horse 4x3 in his pedigree, with Lady Angela (dam of Northern Dancer's sire Nearctic) 6x5x4. Europe is virtually saturated with Northern Dancer line sires and it looks as if Hector Protector and Dr Devious might have a particularly valuable role to play in crossing with Northern Dancer line mares.
