1998 D. G. Van Clief, Jr., president of Breeders' Cup Limited, announced vesterday that Churchill Downs has been selected to host the 1998 Breeders' Cup. The 15th running of the \$11 million-dollar event will be held Saturday, November 7 and will be televised live on NBC Sports from 1-5:30 p.m. "We are very pleased to select Churchill Downs for the fourth time as host of the Breeders' Cup, the most ever for a host track," said Van Clief. "On three previous occasions, the track has showcased outstanding presentations of the Breeders' Cup Championship. We look forward to another first-rate performance next year." The Breeders' Cup was also held at Churchill in 1988, 1991 and 1994.


MARGAUX FARM BUYS INTEREST IN

CAPTAIN BODGIT Team Valor's Captain Bodgit (Saint Ballado) will enter stud at Margaux Farm in Midway, Kentucky next season. Operated by Steve Johnson and Rick Trontz, Margaux Farm has also purchased a half-interest in the colt for \$2.5 million. A winner of seven of his 12 starts and \$1,014,819, Captain Bodgit captured the GI Florida Derby and GII Wood Memorial on his way to this year's Kentucky Derby. Sent off the favorite in the "Run for the Roses," he finished second, just a head behind Silver Charm. He made the final start of his career in the Preakness and finished third in a three-way photo for the win; he suffered a bowed tendon in the race and was retired. Captain Bodgit will stand as the property of a partnership for a fee of \$10,000, live foal. President Barry Irwin said Team Valor would form syndicates to buy mares to breed to the stallion, with the intention of racing the offspring. News cont. p2

Danetime (Ire) ran on to take second place and Tomba (GB) finished strongly to grab third. Danetime's jockey, Michael Kinane, received a two-day ban for careless riding when trying to gain a favorable position early in the race. Winning trainer Barry Hills was delighted with Royal Applause, who made up for his defeat in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 10. "He got a very clean break from the start, which was a big help, and he had all his rivals in trouble at halfway," said Hills. "Unfortunately at Newmarket he didn't get away quickly and came out of the stalls skew-whiff, which meant he was never able to get properly balanced. He is certainly the best sprinter around." The winner's main target will be the Nov. 8 Breeders' Cup Sprint at Hollywood Park, but he may take in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp at Longchamp October 5.
