**JULES RETIRED** Jules (Forty Niner), a graded stakes winner of \$293,320, has been retired after suffering a fractured sesamoid in his right front leg Thursday morning at Monmouth Park. "He breezed five-eighths in 1:00 very easily," said trainer Alan Goldberg. "As he was pulling up, he took a bad step. He cooled out fine, but then had some filling in his leg. We took X-rays and discovered the fracture." Goldberg said that surgery and a return to the races had been considered. "We sent the X-rays to (Dr.) Larry Bramlage, and the fracture was too small to piece together and too large to take out." Goldberg said that stud plans remain undetermined. "He was as fast a horse as I ever trained," said Goldberg, "but he was plagued with a lot of little problems which compromised his ability to exhibit his full potential. But when he was right, he was as good as anybody." Jules won his first start in his six-furlong debut with a 14-length win Sept. 28, 1996 at Belmont, and finished second, beaten a neck, in the GII Cowdin in his next start. He followed that up with a win in the GIII Nashua S. At three, he won the Long Branch S. and was preparing for a start in the September 13 GII Kentucky Cup Sprint when he was injured. Goldberg campaigned Jules for his breeders, the Jayeff B Stables. "He turned in some spectacular performances," said Goldberg, "and has a great sires' pedigree, being by Forty Niner and from the same female family as Northern Dancer and successful sires Danehill and Machiavellian."

Cash Asmussen, who partnered Helissio to finish third in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 26 on his last start, will ride G1 Haras-de-Fresnay-Le-Buffer Prix Jacques Le Marois winner **Spinning World** (Nureyev). The Irish 1000 Guineas winner **Classic Park (GB)** (Robellino) and G1 Coronation S. winner **Rebecca Sharp (GB)** (Machiavellian) represent the three-year-old fillies, while **Bijou D'Inde (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) makes his first start since his fall in the Dubai World Cup in April.

Fortitude made a mild rally when running fourth in the Aug. 15 Gil Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga in his previous start and picked up his first victory here since taking an Oct. 18 Belmont turf allowance race, 10 starts back. The upset winner, trailed the field of eight early, gained rapidly four wide around the far turn, surged to the front in mid-stretch and held off Green Means Go in the final furlong. "I knew there was a lot of speed up front, so I wanted to just sit back and be in a stalking position," winning jockey Robbie Davis said. "I waited for someone to make a move and when I was able to get my horse in the clear, he really took off." Winning trainer H. Allen Jerkens indicated that the winner will be pointed for the Oct. 18 Gil Kelso H. at Belmont. Fortitude's time established a new track record, breaking the previous mark of 1:39 1/5 set by Fleet Victress in 1977. The 2-1 favorite SOVIET LINE (IRE) (Soviet Star) contested a strong pace and faded to fifth to snap his three-race winning streak.
