**BOSRA SHAM TO BREEDERS' CUP** Trainer Henry Cecil plans to send English champion filly **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) to the U.S. this fall to run in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, it was revealed yesterday by the *Racing Post*. The four-year-old, seven-for-10 lifetime with three Group 1 wins to her credit, has suffered defeats in her last two starts, running third in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. in July and fourth in the G1 Juddmonte International last out August 19. She will stretch out to a mile and a half for the first time in the Turf. "She is fine but we are taking things very gently with her," Cecil told the *Racing Post*. "We hope to run her in the Champion S. (which she won last year), and then the Breeders' Cup Turf."

**TOUCH GOLD WORKS FOR PEGASUS; TALE OF THE CAT TO SKIP** Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), the favorite for the the Sept. 20 GII \$1 million Buick Pegasus at the Meadowlands, worked a mile yesterday at Hollywood Park. According to assistant trainer Grant Hofmans, Touch Gold covered the distance in 1:43 3/5 and will ship to New Jersey Thursday. "Everything went good," said Hofmans, whose father, David, is the trainer. "He got tired, but that was to be expected. As far as his foot goes, everything is perfect." In other Pegasus news, trainer John Forbes has pulled **Tale of the Cat** (Storm Cat) out of the race and will run instead in the Sept. 27 GI Vosburgh at Belmont, with the Breeders' Cup Sprint in mind. "There is not a really outstanding sprinter in the country and the Vosburgh is a Grade I race, which were things we had to consider," Forbes said. "We also have to consider his value as a stallion. We know sprinting is something he can be successful at. He's awful quick." Forbes may switch back to the Pegasus if there are any major defections.

Sixth after a rough start in this race last year, **Coup D'Argent** (Silver Buck) ended his 1996 season with a third-place finish in the GII Clark H. November 29, then returned after nearly nine months on the sidelines to take the restricted Harry F. Brubaker H. at Del Mar August 18. He makes his second start off the layoff.

## KEENELAND SEPTEMBER ON RECORD PACE

Through the first five days, the 1997 Keeneland September Yearling Sale is up more than 11 percent for both gross and average over the record-setting 1996 sale. At the half-way point, 1,391 horses have sold for \$126,526,600, an average of \$90,961; after five days last year, 1,389 yearlings had grossed \$113,691,900, an average of \$81,852. The median is holding steady at \$52,000. Friday's session topper was a filly by Septieme Ciel out of the mare Willa Joe (Ire) (El Gran Senor), who is a half-sister to Grade I winners Will's Way (Easy Goer) and Willa On The Move (Assert {Ire}). Consigned by Bayne and Libby Welker, Agent I, the dark bay brought a final bid of \$350,000 from Robert L. Quinichett of Maryland. A total of 287 hips sold for an aggregate \$11,834,400 Friday, up 21.9 percent over the corresponding session last year when 280 yearlings brought \$9,708,000. The average of \$41,235 was up 18.9 percent over the '96 figure of \$34,671, while Friday's median was up 18.5 percent, from \$27,000 in '96 to \$32,000 in '97. The 10-day sale runs through Wednesday, Sept. 17; bidding begins at 10 a.m. daily.

### "AMERICA'S DAY AT THE RACES" A SUCCESS

The inaugural "America's Day at the Races," held Labor Day, Monday, September 1, had a positive effect on both handle and attendance at the majority of the race-tracks involved in the promotion. While attendance figures were not available for four of the tracks (three--Colonial Downs, Prairie Meadows and Remington Park--were not open on Labor Day, 1996), 12 of the 21 which participated in the event showed increased attendance and 10 of 18 reporting '96 figures showed increased handle over last year. "We are pleased with the results of the inaugural America's Day promotion," said Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association President Drew Couto. "It was a privilege to work with the tracks, horsemen and other supporting groups who helped us launch 'America's Day at the Races,' and we look forward to creating an even better event in 1998 with their continued cooperation."
