PILSUDSKI TO SKIP BREEDERS' CUP Last

year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent) put up a high-class performance to take a comfortable win in yesterday's G1 Champion S. at Ireland's Leopardstown race course, but the fivevear-old will not be making a return trip to North America to defend his title. The Irish-bred bay will instead head for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp October 5, where he finished second to Helissio (Fr) last year, and then travel to Tokyo for the Japan Cup at the end of November. Making only his fourth start since his Breeders' Cup triumph, Pilsudski was sent off the prohibitve 5-4 favorite in the Champion. Rated off the early pace, he loomed boldly as the field rounded the home turn, rallying to take control at the quarter pole and drawing away for a comfortable 4 1/2-length success. Winning owner Lord Weinstock said, "He's shown he's as good as ever today. I think it is likely that he will be retired to stud after the Japan Cup." Desert King (Ire) (Danehill), winner of this year's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish Derby, tracked the winner throughout but could not mount a serious challenge in the straight and finished second. The dual Irish Classic winner is, however, no longer certain to run in the Arc. Said trainer Aidan O'Brien, "Pilsudski is a real star and maybe it helped him more than us by us running two pacemakers in today's race. We'll have to think hard about whether Desert King goes to Longchamp or not." (Champion chart, p1)

IS IT TRUE COLT TOPS KEENELAND DAY SIX

A colt by Is It True out of Setting (Exclusive Native) topped Saturday's session of the 1997 Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington, bringing a final bid of \$175,000. The half-brother to stakes-placed Heaven Can Wait (Septieme Ciel) was consigned by Walmac International, agent, and purchased by Mike Pegram. A total of 312 yearlings sold on Saturday's sixth day of the 10-day auction, bringing \$9,256,200, up 15.5 percent from the corresponding session in 1996 when 313 horses grossed \$8,008,500. The 1997 sixth-day average of \$29,667 was up 15.9 percent from last year's figure of \$25,586, while the median price rose 25 percent, from \$20,000 in 1996 to \$25,000 this year.
