KEENELAND SEPTEMBER SALE SETS GROSS SALES RECORD

With three days still remaining, the 1997 Keeneland September Yearling Sale set a record of \$142,771,500 for gross sales, breaking the old mark of \$137,358,600 set last year. Through Sunday's seventh session, 2,018 yearlings have sold for an average of \$70,749. Total sales are up 12.5 percent over the 1996 auction, which had sold a total of 1,988 horses for an aggregate \$126,889,900 through day seven; the average is up 10.8 percent over last year's seven-day figure of \$63,828. Two colts brought bids of \$102,000 to top Sunday's session. The first, a son of Hansel out of Dancing Mahmoud (Topsider) was consigned by Woodlynn Farm, Inc. and purchased by Billy Teinowitz, agent. The second, a half-brother to two stakes-placed runners by Ghazi out of Nashoba (Superbity), was consigned by Mr. and Mrs. Theodore Kuster and purchased by Cecil Seaman, agent. There were 314 yearlings sold Sunday, bringing \$6,984,700 for an average of \$22,244. The gross was up 34.5 percent over last year's corresponding session when 286 horses sold for \$5,189,500; the 1997 average was up 22.5 percent over last year's figure of \$18,145. The sale continues at 10 a.m today.

TRF AUCTION SET FOR SUNDAY The annual Racing Memorabilia Auction to benefit the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation will be held trackside at Belmont Park this Sunday, September 21 at 10 a.m. Seventy lots will be offered, including photos, sales catalogues, out-of-print books, programs, sterling silver Kentucky Derby julep cups, posters, colorful reproductions by Peb and two tickets to this year's Breeders' Cup at Hollywood Park. Proceeds from the auction provide funds for the TRF, which for 15 years has been offering homes to retired racehorses. Richard Rosner from New York's Tepper Galleries will once again serve as auctioneer.

The fastest of the three Arc trials held yesterday and in fact the second-fastest ever running of this race was won by the 18-1 outsider Queen Maud, who gave owner Gary Tanaka, trainer Jean de Roualle and jockey Olivier Peslier their first success in this event. The winner made her bid at the eighth-pole, quickening well to hit the front and running on resolutely for the win. "She was very unlucky in the Prix de Diane (finishing ninth)," said de Roualle, "and when she was third in the Prix Chloe in her last start (July 20), the trip was too short. We thought before today that she might go to Canada for the E. P.Taylor S., but with this result we will have to reconsider and see if she will be pointed for the Arc and then to the Breeders' Cup. The only certainty is that I will celebrate and get drunk tonight!" Prix de Diane runner-up Mousse Glacee, making her first start since that June 8 test, is still possible for the Arc. "She was stopped in training in the summer with a virus and only resumed training earlier this month," said trainer Jean Lesbordes. "She might go to the Arc or go straight to America for some of the big races there."

Itv was an unsatisfactory Arc trial for the 1-10 favourite and G1 Prix du Jockey Club winner Peintre Celebre.

Unable to find room when it mattered in a slowly run race, he left rider Olivier Peslier fuming at ITHAKI's (Saddler's Wells) jockey Cash Asmussen. On the final turn, Rajpoute (Fr) grabbed the lead and went clear, with Peintre Celebre unable to find an opening on the rail. Inside the final furlong the unlucky favorite finally found room and flew home, but it was too late as Rajpoute galloped on resolutely. "Cash Asmussen kept me inside all the way," said Peslier. "Maybe he was riding his race, but when I tried to pull back and go around him, he also took his horse back to stop me. He has ridden the race to get me beaten. Maybe he is trying to settle an account with me because he is no longer riding Helissio (Fr) and because I rode Queen Maud in the Vermeille instead of him." Amidst all the fuss over Peintre Celebre's unlucky run, winning trainer Francois Doumen, who also bred the winner, said, "This victory might now change the course of Rajpoute's career, but it is too early to make a decision over where he will run next." The favorite's trainer Andre Fabre was phlegmatic about the defeat. "This was only a trial for the Arc. I would be much more worried if the ground for the Arc came up soft," he said. Bookmakers Ladbrokes reacted to Peintre Celebre's defeat by making him 4-1 joint second favorite with Helissio for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, with Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent) the new favourite at 3-1 and Swain (Ire) (Nashwan) at 6-1.

Originally campaigned in France, where she won the G3 Prix de Psyche at Deauville last year, Sangria has been competing in North America since shipping in last fall to finish seventh in the E.P. Taylor at Woodbine. She came into this event still looking for her first score on this side of the Atlantic and found it here at the second-longest odds in the field. Never far back, she closed four-wide through the stretch to put a determined nose in front in the final strides. The 3-5 favorite, Shemozzle (Ire), stalked the pace, rallied and just fell short.

Joustabout tried turf for the first time in her second career start and came home a 2 1/2-length winner at 22-1 in a Belmont maiden special weight test July 17. Back on the dirt in her next start, the Florida-bred bay was third, albeit a well-beaten third, in the GI Adirondack S. at Saratoga in her latest August 11. Shipping even farther north this time, the crowd's second choice sat sixth through three-quarters in 1:11 2/5, swept to the lead on the far turn and outfinished favored Port Tack for her first stakes score. "We were a little worried about her being too close to the early pace," said winning jockey Mike Luzzi. "It took me a good eighth of a mile on the backside to get her where I wanted and then she was tucked in nice. Up to the five-sixteenths pole, I kept hoping something would open up for her and it did nicely. She finished well."

Last early while making her turf debut here, she advanced steadily, took over at the top of the stretch and drew off to give her freshman sire his first stakes winner. "We liked her today because she's been working well on the grass," said trainer Tino Attard. "I think we're going to stay on the turf for now."
