KEENELAND MONDAY RESULTS A filly by Alysheba and a colt by Phone Trick each brought \$170,000 to top Monday's session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. Hip number 2659, a chestnut filly by Alysheba out of the graded-stakes winning Viceregal mare Regal Gal, was consigned by Stone Farm, agent and purchased by Stonerside Stable Ltd. The yearling is a half sister to graded stakes winners **Holy Mountain** (Devil's Bag) and **Malagra** (Majestic Light). The second \$170,000 yearling was hip number 2692, a chestnut colt by Phone Trick--Serna, by Cox's Ridge. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, Agent LXXXI, the yearling was purchased by Supervent, Inc. During Monday's session, Keeneland sold 314 horses for a total of \$6,073,800 and an average of \$19,343. The average price is up 35.7 percent from last year's corresponding session when 282 horses sold for \$4,021,000 and an average of \$14,259. With two sessions remaining in the 10-day auction, Keeneland has sold 2,332 horses for a sales record of \$148,845,300, an average of \$63,827. At the same point in last year's sale, 2,270 horses had been sold for \$130,910,800 and an average of \$57,670. The auction continues through Wednesday.

The German-trained colt Starkey (GB), who won the valuable German Listed race Hapag-Lloyd-Fliegerpokal on his previous start at Hanover August 17, is now three-for-three after this fortunate success. Second in the early running, Starkey sat outside pacesetter ELLA (IRE) (Brief Truce) to the straight, where the front runner drifted into the rail and caused favored River Flare to be hard checked. That left the race between Starkey and Shudder (GB), with the former proving the stronger. The crowd's unlucky choice flew home, but all too late.
