### BUCKLAND DISPERSAL SET FOR NOVEMBER

The complete dispersal of Buckland Farm's horses has been scheduled for this year's Keeneland November Sale. More than 120 horses, including 40 broodmares or broodmare prospects, over 35 weanlings and yearlings and 40 horses of racing age, are slated to be sold. W.S. Farish's Lane's End Farm near Versailles, Kentucky will act as agent. The dispersal follows the death of owner Thomas Mellon Evans in July of this year. Evans, a member of The Jockey Club, bred and owned 1981 Kentucky Derby winner Pleasant Colony.

### EIGHT TRACKS SIGN ON FOR HORSE-RACING CHANNEL

Eight racetracks have signed multi-year agreements with ODS Entertainment to be part of the Television Games Network, a national entertainment and wagering network set to begin broadcasting in the final quarter of 1998. The tracks which have signed on to supply the majority of their races to ODS for home wagering over the next five years are Churchill Downs, Gulfstream Park, Hollywood Park, Laurel Park, Lone Star Park, Pimlico, Santa Anita and Turfway Park. TVG will be available via cable, digital television systems and satellite television; the 24-hour channel will feature live racing, inserts for local racing, tutorials, interactive advertisement and merchandising. The ODS system has been successfully tested in the Louisville area since 1995. With the advent of TVG, interactive home wagering will become available in Connecticut, Maryland, Nevada, New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Oregon.

Swain (Ire)'s odds for winning the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe drifted from 4-1 to 7-1 after he was surprisingly beaten by Posidonas (GB) and Arabian Story (GB) in a battling finish. Swain's pacemaker SUN-BEAM DANCE (Gone West) led with two furlongs to run, where he was joined by Posidonas, Arabian Story and Swain on the wide outside. Swain hit the front at the eighth marker and looked set for a comfortable success but Posidonas and Arabian Story fought back in gutsy fashion to relegate Swain to third place. Winning trainer Paul Cole indicated the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp October 5 as Posidonas's next target, saying, "The owner is very keen to go there and this is still a fresh horse. He's a pleasure to train and loves a scrap." A typically bullish Frankie Dettori said of Swain's defeat, "He needed the race and was giving weight all round. This was just a stepping stone to the Arc and I am sure he will be the same horse as he was in the King George at the Arc." #### NOTABLE NEWCOMER

Two-year-old **Loving Claim** (Hansel) gave a sparkling debut yesterday for trainer Criquelette Head. The filly, in front from the start, quickened at the top of the stretch to go away and win by four lengths. Her trainer said: "She's my best juvenile filly right now. I had already entered her in the (G1) **Prix Marcel Boussac** at Longchamp (October 5), that's how highly I rated her. She might come back for that race, but it may come too soon and she might lack enough experience to tackle it on only her second start."

#### Local News, England:

Eleven-time champion jockey Pat Eddery, who rode his 4,000th British winner aboard **Silver Patriarch (Ire)** in the **Pertemps St Leger-G1** at Doncaster last Saturday, has announced that he will be forced to miss the rest of the season due to a back injury. The injury dates back to a ride at Nottingham in April when Eddery ricked his back leaving the stalls. Eddery said "It's been there a long time, I damaged a disc. It isn't painful when I ride but there are some good days and some bad days. I won't be riding in the winter but I will be back for next season. It's a blow to miss the rest of the season but it's happened. I saw the doctor on Thursday and he said I have got to have an operation."
