

Vasquez, the meet's leading rider, was unseated when he lost an iron as the field headed into the final turn. He was kicked by a trailing horse, suffering severe head injuries. This was the second serious accident at the track this meet; jockey Miguel Figueroa died of head injuries after a spill Friday, September 12.
