TOUCH GOLD TRAILS IN PEGASUS The

winner of the GI Belmont S. and GI Buick Haskell Invitational, Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) was 2-5 to take last night's GII Buick Pegasus H. at the Meadowlands but never got into the race. Last from gate to wire, the colt trailed in 16 1/4 lengths behind runaway winner Behrens (Pleasant Colony), who stopped the timer in 1:46 3/5 for the mile and an eighth, just one tick off the track record. "I'm flabbergasted," said Touch Gold's rider, Chris McCarron. "He didn't have any problems. I don't understand why he ran the way he did. He was disinterested, that's the only way to describe it." Winning trainer Jim Bond, who earlier saddled Will's Way to a third-place finish in the GI Woodward, was ecstatic. "Six hours ago, I was broken-hearted," he said. "Now I'm smiling--what a day!" (Pegasus chart, p2)

**GENTLEMEN PREFERS DIRT?** Bet down to 2-5 in vesterday's GIC Woodbine Mile after three straight Grade I wins on the dirt. Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois) had trouble handling the soft turf and staggered home fifth behind impressive 1 1/2-length winner Geri (Theatrical {Ire}). The five-year-old settled in second through the early fractions and took the lead briefly midstretch, but was drifting out in the final drive while tiring in his first turf start since last November. "He didn't like the soft going at all," said jockey Gary Stevens. "He was struggling throughout. As soon as I had to start riding him, he lost all his confidence and just didn't give me a lot of effort in the stretch." Added trainer Richard Mandella, "Cooling out he seemed awfully upset about something, so we scoped him and found he's got an ulcer. My first impression was that he didn't care too much for the turf and wasn't getting hold of it, but maybe his throat was burning him pretty good, too. This I'm sure is treatable and should clear up pretty good. We'll be flushing him and putting him on antibiotics. Whether we can get it cleared up enough that it doesn't interfere with the Breeders' Cup (Nov. 8), we'll just have to see." (Woodbine Mile chart, p2)

Coming off an impressive wire-to-wire track recordsetting victory in the GII Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park August 23, Formal Gold was the slight choice to duplicate that performance here. The dark bay once again went right to the lead, but was joined by longshot PACIFIC FLEET (Afleet) and second choice Skip Away as they raced down the backstretch. Pacific Fleet gave it up after a quarter and the two favorites were left to fight it out on the front end, but the battle was over before it began as Formal Gold effortlessly opened up daylight as they raced into the stretch and was never threatened in another convincing score. "I've never had a horse give me his life like he does," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. "He just dragged me up to the lead. When I dropped his head, he just took right off. The most amazing thing about this race was how easily he got way from the other two. He'll sleep well tonight, I'll tell you that. He's an aggressive horse all the way, and a pleasure to ride." As for another shot at the Breeders' Cup Classic, in which Formal Gold finished fifth last year, owner Jack Murphy said, "I know he can win the Breeders' Cup. I'm the only one who has said he can get a mile and a guarter, but if you look at his races at a mile and a quarter he had a good excuse in every one of them." Trainer Bill Perry said his colt would make his next start in the Classic at Hollywood Park November 8. Will's Way rallied from just off the pace to take second at the top of the lane, but Skip Away came back gamely to snag the runner-up spot in the final strides. "We'll just have to win the (Jockey Club) Gold Cup (Oct. 18), that's all," said his trainer, Sonny Hine. "We'll go in there and then give him about three or four months off." Skip Away is not Breeders' Cup eligible.

Behrens started his career with three straight wins, including the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont July 5, but then was fourth as the 2-1 favorite in the GII Jim Dandy S. over a sloppy track at Saratoga. Stretching out for the GI Travers in his next start, the bay put in a gallant performance, engaging Deputy Commander in a dog fight from the top of the stretch to the wire to miss by the smallest of margins. Dropping nine pounds off that race as the lightweight in this field, he dueled Anet through six furlongs in 1:09 4/5 before shaking loose and galloping away from his three rivals, crossing the line in a time just one fifth off the track record. "He's getting better all the time," said winning trainer Jim Bond. "I never had a horse come out of such a tough race (the Travers) and come back like that. He gained weight and you usually expect them to lose it." As for what's next, he said, "The Breeders' Cup is one of our goals, but I'll have to speak to the Rudders and see what they want to do. I just want to do what's right for the horse." The 2-5 favorite TOUCH GOLD (Deputy Minister) broke last, stayed in touch with the field for six furlongs and faded badly in the drive. "(Jockey Chris McCarron) said he tried to drift out," said his trainer, David Hofmans. "He was asking him to run, but the horse just didn't have it. I don't think the foot was bothering him. He looked okay out there."

A Grade I winner on the dirt after taking the 1996 Oaklawn H., Geri was winless in his next five starts before stepping onto the turf for the first time and taking a Belmont allowance race by six lengths June 14. Runner-up in the GI Caesars International in his next start, he then took two months off before coming back in the GI Arlington Million August 24 and finishing fifth, beaten just 2 1/2 lengths. The second choice at a generous 8-1 here, the five-vear-old teamed up with jockey Chris Antley once again; unhurried through three-quarters in 1:10 2/5, the chestnut came flying on the far outside at the finish to take the lead in the final furlong and edge clear. "We always felt this horse was capable of beating almost anyone," said trainer Bill Mott. "We put him on the grass and backed him up to a mile and he showed us today what a trooper he is." Mott will point the Allen Paulson homebred for the Breeders' Cup Mile at Hollywood Park November 8; runner-up Helmsman also heads for that spot. The 2-5 favorite, GENTLE-MEN (ARG) (Robin des Bois) had captured the GI Pimlico Special, GI Hollywood Gold Cup and GI Pacific Classic on the dirt in his last three starts. Trying turf for the first time since taking the GII Citation H. at Hollywood last November 30, the odds-on choice pressed pacesetter KIRIDASHI (Bold Ruckus) to the top of the stretch and put a head in front at the eighth pole but weakened while drifting out and had to settle for fifth. Tomisue's Delight won an Apr. 9 Aqueduct allowance event against her elders and then finished second or third in four consecutive Grade I races facing three-yearold fillies, including a third-place performance last time out in the Aug. 16 Gl Alabama S. Sporting blinkers for the first time, the chestnut raced close to the pace on the outside, was roused around the far turn and came rolling down the stretch to catch Clear Mandate for her first stakes win. "(Trainer Neil Howard) gave me the option of riding her how I liked and it went well," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "I thought Clear Mandate was the horse to beat, so I just wanted to put my filly on her heels. She was just off her and as a result, she did not have to overcome a great deal turning for home and she was able to close it out." Howard pointed to the equipment change as a possible reason for the victory. "Obviously, the blinkers helped a little," he said. "This is a big filly and she can get a little lackadaisical at times. We'll see how she comes out of this race and decide where we'll run her next. It's tough putting a three-year-old filly in the Breeders' Cup." Clear Mandate, winner of the Aug. 22 Gl John A. Morris H. at Saratoga last time out, contested the pace and gave way in the lane. "She ran a great race, I can't complain one bit," said her jockey, Mike Smith. "We were with the pace, and I know we were going slow and all, but with this filly I really wanted a target to run at."
