STEPHENS RETIRES Hall of Fame conditioner Woody Stephens has turned over the last two horses in his barn to former assistant Billy Badgett and is now officially retired. Stephens, 84, still owns the pair of horses he had been training, Validate and Staunch. In semi-retirement for the last several years while assistant Sandy Bruno tended to the day-to-day activities of the stable, Stephens recently decided that even his limited role was too demanding. "I'm 84-years-old, I've been around the track for 67 years and, of course, I've got emphysema," Stephens said. "It's been tough. I didn't even come out to see Validate (yesterday in his first start for Badgett). It got to the point where it became quite an effort for me."

CLASSIC CLICHE OUT TO PASTURE Following his last-place finish in Saturday's Jefferson Smurfit Irish St. Leger at The Curragh, Godolphin's five-year-old Classic Cliche (Ire) (Salse) has been retired. Named highweight three-year-old in England at over 14 furlongs in 1995, the bay won the 1995 G1 Doncaster Leger, the 1996 G1 Ascot Gold Cup and the G2 Prix Kerogolay at Deauville this past August 24. Classic Cliche was being aimed at Australia's Melbourne Cup in November, but Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford said Sunday: "There is nothing wrong but he is not enjoying his racing as he used to. He has been a magnificent servant and will now be retired to stud." During his European campaign, Classic Cliche earned over \$1 million in 16 starts. recording six victories.

Winning trainer Howie Tesher was unable to be at Belmont since he was in Florida for the funeral of Influent's former co-owner Richard Kumble. "Fortunately everything worked out," Tesher said by phone. "I still say he doesn't need the lead to win, but I guess he runs best from there. Everybody was talking about Influent at the funeral, I was really choked up when he won." The winner connections also made a decision to switch riders to Jerry Bailey. "Jean-Luc (Influent's former jockey Sannyn) was riding him well," Tesher said. "But we just thought we'd do something different, and got Jerry to ride him. Everybody was joking because at the time of the decision, Jerry was 0-for-the-meet, but we wanted the best, and that's what we got.' Awad closed strongly to finish third. "We may run in the Turf Classic but the main goal is the Breeders' Cup," trainer David Donk said. The 5-2 second-choice ANNUS MIRABILIS (Warning {GB}) shipped in from England for this engagement but tired in the drive after tracking the winner early.


