PILSUDSKI SOLD TO JAPAN The 1996 Breeders' Cup Turf hero Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent) has been sold to the Japan Racing Association, according to a report in yesterday's Racing Post. The deal is believed to value the five-year-old at between $\$ 7$ and $\$ 8$ million. Pilsudski is scheduled to run next in the Oct. 5 Prix de I' Arc de Triomphe, a race he finished second in last year and will probably end his career in the Japan Cup this November. The Racing Post reports the horse's ownership will switch from his breeder Lord Weinstock to the JRA prior to the Japan Cup. Pilsudski has raced 19 times with eight wins for earnings of $\$ 2,359,910$.

TRF AUCTION A SUCCESS Racing fans bid high at the Annual Fall Auction of Racing Memorabilia to benefit the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation on Super Sunday, September 21 at Belmont Park. "The Annual Fall Memorabilia Auction was initiated in 1985 by Elinor Penna and has been one of our most important and popular fundraising events ever since," said TRF president and founder Monique Koehler. "We are indebted also to the New York Racing Association for again lending Belmont's trackside breakfast area for this event and to the many volunteers, donors and bidders who contributed to its success."
