EDITOR'S NOTE RETIRED Editor's Note (Forty Niner), who captured the GI Belmont S. and GI Super Derby at three but could win only a Belmont allowance race in nine starts this year at four, has been retired to Overbrook Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The chestnut, a \$125,000 Keeneland September yearling, earned his first stakes victory in the Gill Kentucky Cup Juvenile at Turfway Park and went on to be third in the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Following the Florida trail to the 1996 Triple Crown, he was second in both the Gill Holy Bull S. and GI Florida Derby, then third in the Gill Blue Grass S. and GI Preakness before defeating eventual Eclipse Award winner Skip Away by a length in the mile-and-a-half Belmont S. His Super Derby score in September of that year would be his last stakes victory; the colt subsequently finished off the board in six straight starts before taking a mile-and-a-sixteenth allowance July 11. Sent off at 15-1 in last Saturday's GI Woodward S. in his final appearance, he finished fifth, beaten 58 3/4 lengths. "He's retiring completely sound," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, "he's just lost interest. He is perfect physically, but he's not giving us the mental effort." Bred in Kentucky by Fawn Leap Farm, the colt will stand at Overbrook for a fee of \$10,000, live foal. "He has the potential to be a very good sire," said Lukas. "He has a lot of fire, and sometimes those horses that are difficult to handle as racehorses make the best sires. He also has very, very strong conformation. He's a very good-looking horse." Editor's Note retires with a record of six wins from 31 starts and earnings of \$1,601,394.

TALE OF THE CAT SALE A DONE DEAL A half interest in GII King's Bishop winner **Tale of the Cat** (Storm Cat) has been sold to Coolmore Stud, trainer John Forbes has confirmed. The deal, which had been in the works for some time, was finalized yesterday. Forbes confirmed that Coolmore paid \$7.1 million to Phantom House Farm syndicate for the share in Tale of the Cat, who is expected to be the favorite in tomorrow's GI Vosburgh at Belmont. Under the agreement, Tale of the Cat will run in the name of Phantom House Farm and Mrs. John T. Magnier. He will continue to race next year and then will go to stud. According to Forbes, Tale of the Cat will stand at Coolmore's Ashford Stud in Kentucky. Forbes will continue to train the colt throughout his racing career. "I'm a little bit amazed about the whole thing, to tell you the truth," Forbes said. "The bottom line was that there weren't a whole lot of attractive sire prospects around right now besides him."

BREEDERS' CUP NEXT FOR FORMAL GOLD

Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) is set to pass the Oct. 18 Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont and head straight to the Nov. 8 Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park, owner John D. Murphy Sr. confirmed yesterday. "Unless something happens to change my mind, we won't be going (to the Gold Cup)," said Murphy. Murphy and trainer William Perry had been uncertain about their plans after Formal Gold's Sept. 20 Woodward victory, but Murphy now says the camp firmly believes passing the Gold Cup is the way to go. "I would love to run, because I love New York, but two mile-and-a-quarter races within three weeks is a lot to ask of a horse when you're going up against the best around."

LIVELY ONE TO FRANKS FARM Multiple graded stakes winning stallion **Lively One** (Halo--Swinging Lizzie, by The Axe II) has been relocated from Stone Farm in Kentucky to Franks Farm in Ocala, Florida for the 1998 breeding season. Lively One captured the 1988 GI Swaps S., 1990 GII Goodwood H., 1989 GIII Cabrillo H. and GIII San Diego H. in a nine-win, 36-race career in which he earned \$1,544,100. With four crops to race, the 12-year-old has sired stakes-winning and graded-stakes placed She's a Lively One and stakes winners One Mean Man and Steprock.

John Gosden's Decorated Hero (GB) gained his second Group 3 prize of the season and his 10th win from 22 lifetime starts when running out a convincing winner here. Decorated Hero, one of Frankie Dettori's "Magnificent Seven" at last year's Ascot Festival, was settled at the rear of the field as OH NELLIE (Tilt the Stars) and RED CAMELLIA (GB) (Polar Falcon) set a strong early pace. As the field passed the two-furlong pole the complexion of the race changed as jockey Olivier Peslier produced the favorite with a decisive turn of foot and the result was never in doubt as Decorated Hero held on comfortably for a 1 1/4-length success. The winner's next likely target is the \$119,104 G2 Challenge S., over seven furlongs at Newmarket, Oct 18.
