"VICTOR" VICTORIOUS IN VOSBURGH

Turning down the role of bridesmaid after finishing second in five straight, Victor Cooley (Cool Victor) came charging from just off the pace to headline in Saturday's GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont Park. The 6-1 third choice, he outfinished 23-1 Score a Birdie (Proud Birdie) to win by a length and a half. "I knew my horse was ready to run a winning race today," said jockey Jorge Chavez, who picked up the mount for the GII Forego H. at Saratoga last out September 1. "It was better today than when I rode him for the first time. I know him better now. He ran a big race." The winner of the 1996 GIC Queen's Plate at a mile and a quarter and last year's champion three-year-old in Canada, Victor Cooley showed his versatility with a win in the seven-furlong GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup at Keeneland April 13. But the dark bay had failed to score in five subsequent starts while running second in graded stakes from seven furlongs to a mile and an eighth. Malcolm Pierce, assistant to trainer Mark Frostad, credited Chavez for the gelding's return to the winner's circle. "He needed somebody to make him finish strong," said Pierce. "He ran big in the Forego, and after the race Jorge said, put me back on him and I'll win.' He did what he promised us." As for what's next, Pierce said, "We may run him in the Ack Ack H. (October 26) at Churchill Downs, but right now we're going to go back home and think things over. The Breeders' Cup is not out of the question." Even-money favorite Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat), making his first appearance since Coolmore Stud purchased a half-interest in the colt for \$7.1 million, broke sharply, was rated just off the pace and dropped back going into the far turn, but rallied from between horses in the stretch to be third, a neck behind Score a Birdie. "When he got that first wave of dirt in his face, he reacted to it for about 30 yards," said trainer John Forbes. "That's when he lost ground and he didn't get it back. This is why we talk about seasoning. These are older, hardened sprinters and losing to them is not a disgrace." Forbes added he would likely still point the colt for the Breeders' Cup Sprint at Hollywood November 8. (Vosburgh chart, p2)

Italian and German 2000 Guineas winner Air Express (Ire) upset the hotshots with a dramatic victory over the unlucky Rebecca Sharp (GB), the only filly in the field, to gain his first Group One success. "I've always thought he was a Group One horse," said delighted trainer Clive Brittain. "Everything went according to plan and Olivier Peslier rode him perfectly. I thought he was outstanding odds for the race. If I had been a betting man, I would have had a big bet on him, too. He could go for the Breeders' Cup Mile, but I would prefer to send him to the Hong Kong Invitational in December--I fancy some Chinese!" Godolphin's ALLIED FORCES (Miswaki) set the early pace from BIJOU D'INDE (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), with Air Express towards the rear. At the half-mile, Bijou D'Inde grabbed the lead and still held it well into the stretch, with Faithful Son challenging, but Peslier brought Air Express through smoothly on the outside and took command at the eighth pole. Rebecca Sharp could not find an opening and had to be switched to the outside in deep stretch; she failed by only a nose to catch the winner. Her rider Michael Hills was disconsolate afterwards, saying: "The gap just wasn't there when I wanted it, but as soon as I switched, it opened." BAHHARE (Woodman), having only his second race of the year, just failed to catch Faithful Son for third. Said trainer John Dunlop, "That was a really good run. He was left on his haunches in the gate. Judging by the way he finished, he should get further and will probably run in the (G1) Champion S. at Newmarket (Oct. 18)." ENTREPRENEUR (GB) (Sadler's Wells), seventh, was described as "rusty" by his rider Michael Kinane, while the favourite REVOQUE (IRE) (Fairy King) never showed with a chance and his rider John Reid was stunned. "He did not pick up at all. Nothing happened when I asked him," said Reid.

Runner-up for the fifth consecutive time in the GII Forego H. in his latest September 1, Cool Victor turned the tables on Forego winner Score a Birdie with a strong closing kick that carried him clear in the final drive. Enjoying a seven-pound swing in the weights, the fouryear-old pressed the pace through a half in :45.39, took command as they straightened into the stretch and outgamed his 23-1 rival for the victory. "This is just fantastic," said Malcolm Pierce, assistant to trainer Mark Frostad. "It's thrilling for us to be here and it's a bigger thrill that we won. It's good to finally win one." The even-money favorite after a spectacular performance winning the GII King's Bishop August 23 at Saratoga, three-year-old Tale of the Cat took on older horses in only his fifth career start. The dark bay was rated just off the pace and lost ground on the final turn but came again to just miss second in a photo. "I told Julie (jockey Krone) not to use him up, and she followed my directions," said trainer John Forbes. "She said that he broke well, but she felt in order to keep her position she would have had to ride him way, way too hard, which is what I told her not to do. We all tend to second-quess, but we couldn't keep going without letting this horse get dirt in his face. If you ask the question `Can he rate?' the answer is `I guess so'." The colt is expected to make his next start in the Breeders' Cup Sprint November 8.

The odds-on favorite in her graded-stakes debut, Silver Maiden had beaten the colts in her most recent trip to the post, taking the prep for the GII Arlington-Washington Futurity, the Honest Pleasure S., by a length and a half September 13. The CHRB has allocated \$31,000 to the Equine Analytical Chemistry Laboratory at the University of California, Davis, for the study of methocarbamol, a mild muscle relaxant, and the two anti-ulcer medications ranitidine and cimetidine. The Board has already established authorized levels of eight therapeutic medications after determining that, at or below those levels, the medications do not effect athletic performance.
