### “DEPUTY” DOMINATES SUPER DERBY

**XVIII** Once again showing his affinity for the classic distance of a mile and quarter, **Deputy Commander** (Deputy Minister) went right to the front in yesterday's GI \$500,000 Super Derby, set a pressured pace and then opened up on his five rivals in the final furlong to post a three-length victory at Louisiana Downs. The Kentucky-bred colt, who had to fight for a gallant nose decision in the 10-furlong GI Travers S. at Saratoga August 23, had an easier time of it against this field. Pressed by 3-5 **Free House** (Smokester) through six furlongs in 1:11 2/5, the dark bay lost the lead as they raced into the far turn, but took control as the favorite faded, turned back a challenge from **Blazing Sword** (Sword Dance {Ire}) at the quarter-pole and drew off under jockey Chris McCarron. "If Free House wanted to be in front, I was going to stalk him," said McCarron. "If he let me have the lead, he could stalk me. I wasn't concerned with him pressuring me, because I was in the garden spot. I was just concerned with getting my horse to relax. I got down on him at the three-sixteenths pole; I wanted a good kick and he gave it to me." **Precocity** (Aferd), at 61-1 the longest shot on the board, closed for second and 24-1 **Blazing Sword** held on for third. Plans for the winner are up in the air, but trainer Wally Dollase appears to be leaning away from the Breeders' Cup. "I don't want to push him too much against the older horses now, because I don't want him to get beat and discourage him. This horse is going to be better at four and five anyway. He might be one of the major players if I use my common sense. We need to see how he comes out of this race and reevaluate." The colt could go next in the GI Crown Royal Hollywood Derby on the grass November 30. As for Free House, the grey faltered in the drive and finished last. "When we got to the half-mile pole my horse started to make a little whistle noise," said his jockey, Alex Solis. "I don't think he's ever done that before...when we got to the turn, he just completely quit and that was it. I'm sure there had to be something wrong with his breathing, maybe a displaced palate or something." (*Super Derby chart, p2*)

Next year's Epsom Oaks rather than the English 1000 Guineas is the main target for Glorosa (Fr), who captured her second victory from three starts and reversed the form of the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster September 11, where she finished third. The May Hill winner, Midnight Line, was unlucky in this race, being badly checked twice in the straight and ending up fifth. Glorosa, travelling smoothly throughout, challenged for the lead as they headed into the straight and went clear. Only the favourite Jibe and Exclusive (GB) made any ground on her in the closing stages, and this trio finished well clear of the rest. Trainer Luca Cumani, whose filly Papering (Ire) also won the G2 Premio Lydia Tesio in Rome Sunday, praised jockey Frankie Dettori. "He gave her a great ride, but then he's an exceptional rider," said Cumani.

"Glorosa is bred to be a mile-and-a-half filly and next year's Oaks looks to be her race. She will be much stronger next year and she is now finished for this season. Not having run since she won on her debut at Newmarket (July 18), she really needed that race at Doncaster (September 11) and looked much fitter today. I was so happy to see her travelling so well and she did it nicely." Added Dettori, "I rode her at work at Newmarket last week and I could not believe how much she had improved since Doncaster. I knew then that she would run a big race today. I had planned to make all the running, but they went so fast I had to do adopt another plan. She did it really well today and I'm sure she'll be better next year."

Deputy Commander notched his first stakes victory when wiring the field in the June 15 Gill Affirmed H., then finished second to FREE HOUSE (Smokester) in the July 20 Gill Swaps S., but came back with a win in the Aug. 23 GI Travers S. last time out. The second choice gained the advantage from the inside in the first eighth, was headed by Free House three furlongs out and again by Blazing Sword at the top of the stretch, but had plenty left and pulled away handily in the final drive.

"This is a nice horse, and his run in the Travers looked even better with (Travers runner-up) Behrens winning the Pegasus the other night," said winning jockey Chris McCarron, who is now two-for-two on the colt. Precocity, a well-beaten fourth in the Gill Alabama Derby over this track last out August 30, closed from fifth to edge Blazing Sword for second as the dark horse in this field. Free House, the 7-10 favorite, tired to finish last, nine lengths behind the winner.

Having taken until the end of August to register his first group win of the season in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville, Taipan (Ire) always looked in command here, travelling smoothly in behind the leader Luso (GB), who set a moderate pace. The second choice took control early in the stretch and although Luso would not give in without a struggle, John Dunlop's colt ran on well for the victory. Veteran Protektor (Ger) rallied for third.

Heavily backed from 16-1 down to 9-1, Teapot Row (Ire) picked up his third win from four career starts. Always handily placed, the colt came through to grab the lead at the quarter pole and, despite swerving towards the stands rail, ran on too strongly for his rivals. Toller, not able to find a good viewing position, was not confident that his colt had won. "I was a bit anxious as I couldn't see if he'd got up or not," he said. "We've got to be thinking of next year's Derby now, but that's a long way off. I've always thought he was good and he's just gone on improving." Owner the Duke of Devonshire in fact favours a tilt at the English 2000 Guineas. "I think the horse is more of a 2000 Guineas type, though we could also go on to Epsom for the Derby," he said. "This win gives us something to think about during the winter." Jockey Seb Sanders, who has made an impressive breakthrough to the top rank this year--his wins including a surprise July Cup victory with Compton Place (GB)--was full of admiration for his mount. "Teapot Row's not very big, but he's got a big heart and that matters more than anything else," he remarked. "I was always confident of winning after the turn. He got tired up the hill and began to hang, but he finished it off well at the end. The Classics are a long way off, but we can look forward to them now."

Renewed, third-place finisher in the July 20 GIII Lexington S. at Belmont, won a Sept. 17 \$70,000 claimer on the Belmont turf last time out. Stepping up several rungs off the effort, the dark bay was overlooked at the windows but made a bid around the second turn and moved up along the inside in the stretch to get up for a narrow victory. "He's a nice horse, and he's very good since he got to grass racing," winning jockey Filliberto Leon said. "Today everything went right. We got the right pace, saved ground and then came running in the stretch. We had a shot in the lane and when the hole opened up for him, he shot through." Winning trainer Carlos Martin plans to make the Oct. 19 GII Jamaica H. at Belmont the final start of 1997 for Renewed. "He'll be even better as a four-year-old," Martin said. "He's a hard-knocking horse that has been a model of consistency. He was an iron horse for me all year, and he deserves a break." **CASEY TIBBS (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells), the 5-2 favorite after finishing second in the GI Secretariat S. August 24, prompted the pace to the quarter-pole but weakened in the stretch to be eighth.

Chief Bearhart, winner of the Apr. 25 Gil Elkhorn S. at Keeneland, captured the June 14 GIII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine and then was beaten a head in the July 4 GIII Stars & Stripes Breeders' Cup Turf H. last time out. Forced out of the GI Arlington Million August 24 when he developed a temperature the morning of the race, he was returning after nearly three months off. The slight favorite trailed the field of six early before moving up around the far turn to engage Mid-America Triple winner Honor Glide at the top of the stretch; he rolled past that rival in the lane for an easy victory. "(Jockey Garrett Gomez, aboard Honor Glide) was looking for me on the inside, so I went to the outside," said winning jockey Jose Santos. "When you have the best horse in the race, you can do a lot of things. I don't want to take anything away from (Honor Glide), but Chief Bearhart was much the best in this group." Trainer Mark Frostad said the colt would make his next appearance in the GI Canadian International October 19, and could head to Hollywood for the Breeders' Cup Turf November 8. The runner-up, who completed his Triple with a win in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington August 24, had his four-race win streak snapped facing older horses in his first try at a mile and three-eighths. "He ran a huge race," said jockey Garrett Gomez. "He'd never been that far before. I think he's the best three-year-old grass horse on the continent."
