HOUGHTON YEARLING SALE GETS

UNDERWAY A total of 351 hips have been catalogued for the 1997 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale, which begins today at Park Paddocks in Newmarket, England. Many of the world's premier stallions will be represented, including Alleged, Caerleon, Danzig, Fairy King, Gulch, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Rainbow Quest, Sadler's Wells, Seeking the Gold and Woodman. The first Sunday Silence yearling to be sold outside of Japan will be offered as Hip #79; the colt, consigned by Camas Park Stud, is a son of Lingerie (GB) (Shirley Heights {GB}), herself a daughter of European champion filly Northern Trick. A yearling from the first crop by two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner Lure will sell as Hip #98; the filly, consigned by Ted Voute, agent, is out of GISW Miss Josh (Nasty and Bold). The star-studded catalogue includes: a half-sister to European champion Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest), by Barathea (Ire); a half-brother to last year's European champion two-year-old Revoque (Ire) (Fairy King), by Scenic (Ire); a full-sister to European champion two-year-old filly Hoh Magic (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}); a full-brother to 1997 English 2000 Guineas winner Entrepreneur (GB) (Sadler's Wells); a half-brother to two-time European champion sprinter Cadeaux Genereux (GB) (Young Generation {Ire}), by Arazi; a half-sister to 1996 Breeders' Cup Turf winner Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent), by Sadler's Wells; and a colt by Bering (GB) out of European champion older mare and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Urban Sea (Miswaki), already named Urban Ocean. Bidding for the three-day sale begins at 4:45 p.m. Tuesday, 1 p.m. Wednesday and 5:15 p.m. Thursday.

Shmoose is currently the 8-1 ante-post favorite for the 1998 1000 Guineas. Godolphin's highly-rated two-year-old, a daughter of 1989 1000 Guineas second Kerrera, was supplemented to the race at a cost of \$19,057. She makes her second career start after coasting to a 1 1/2-length victory in her debut at Newbury August 15.

TEJANO RUN RETIRED Ending his career on a winning note after taking the GIII Turfway Championship Saturday, **Tejano Run** (Tejano) has been retired after re-aggravating a suspensory injury in the race. Trainer Ken McPeck noticed filling in the five-year-old's right front suspensory in the winner's circle Saturday. It was the latest in a line of leg and stomach ailments which have plagued the chestnut's career since he finished second in the 1995 Kentucky Derby. A graded-stakes winner at two, four and five and on both turf and dirt, Tejano Run goes to the breeding shed with a record of eight wins, four seconds and six thirds from 21 starts and earnings of \$1,166,840. "It's been an honor to train him," said McPeck. "It's required a huge amount of patience, but it's always been worthwhile." Stud plans have yet to be finalized. "I think he'll make a good outcross to the Mr. Prospector and Northern Dancer lines," said McPeck. "There are more breeders who say we need to breed back to stamina and he may fit there."

PLEASANT COLONY, PLEASANT TAP TO LANE'S END Champion **Pleasant Colony** (His Majesty) and his leading money-winning son, champion **Pleasant Tap**, have been relocated to W. S. Farish's Lane's End Farm near Versailles, Kentucky. Winner of the 1981 Kentucky Derby, Pleasant Colony has sired more than 55 stakes winners including champions St. Jovite and Pleasant Stage; his progeny have earned more than \$33 million. He will stand for a fee of \$60,000, live foal, in 1998. Pleasant Tap, an Eclipse winner of over \$2.7 million, has sired stakes winner Willing and stakes-placed Dove Shell and Erv from two crops to race. He will stand for a fee of \$7,500, live foal, next year.
