DIESIS FILLY TOPS HOUGHTON SECOND DAY

The very last lot in the ring Wednesday night, a bay filly by Diesis (GB)--Alamosa (GB) (Alydar), topped the second session of the Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales in Newmarket, England. Consigned by Chris Budgett's Kirtlington Stud, the yearling brought a final bid of \$833,730 from Sheikh Hamdan al-Maktoum's Shadwell Estates. A total of 145 yearlings were sold during the sale's second day for a total of \$25,175,322 and an average of \$173,623. The average price was down 22.7 percent from last year's corresponding session when 91 horses sold for a total of \$20,439,733 and an average of \$224,612. The sale concludes today.

RECORD EASTERN FALL YEARLING SALE

CONCLUDES The most successful yearling sale in Timonium's history ended Tuesday night with records set in gross, average and high-price at Fasig-Tipton's Eastern Fall Yearling Sale. A total of 456 yearlings sold for \$7,702,800, representing an increase in 51 percent over last year's gross. The overall average of \$16,892 for two days jumped 22 percent from the corresponding average of 1996. The new record for a Timonium yearling was set when Mikel Harrington paid \$220,000 for hip number 347, a colt by Waquoit--Miss Buck Trout (Spend a Buck). The seller was Walnut Green (Jones Bros), as agent for the colt's breeders Mrs. Miles Valentine. The highestpriced filly of the two-day sale at \$150,000 was hip number 511, a daughter of Two Punch--Showers (Northern Baby), from the Chanceland Farm consignment. She was purchased by Samantha Siegel, accompanied at the sale by trainer Randy Bradshaw, representing the team of Jan, Mace and Samantha Siegel.

PEDIGREE SHORTS

Following the success of his first crop daughter Meadow Star, who was out of an In Reality mare, the Meadowlake/In Reality cross has been tried several more times, but until last weekend it had provided just one other stakes winner (Streamer, another member of Meadowlake's first crop). However, Saturday saw an impressive win for Medford (c, 2, Meadowlake--Really Quick, by In Reality) in the Dover S. at Delaware Park, and just a day later Ninth Inning (f, 2, Meadowlake--La Finale, by In Reality) cruised home in a Belmont maiden in her debut. If Meadowlake really does have an affinity for In Reality it would not be surprising. Meadowlake carries Eight Thirty and In Reality is inbred to War Relic. Eight Thirty and War Relic supply reverse crosses of the genetic relatives Friar Rock and Man o' War. We do also note a double of War Relic in the pediaree of Meadowlake's very speedy daughter Meafara.

It's clear that Dixieland Band likes the strain of Ribot through Graustark, His Majesty and Hoist the Flag, and Friday night provided another example in the shape of Dixie Bayou (g, 4, Dixieland Band--Marie de Chantilly, by Alleged), who took the GIII Cliff Hanger H. at the Meadowlands. Hoist the Flag's son Alleged provides a particularly interesting combination for Dixieland Band, and it has produced a previous stakes winner in Dixieland Dream. The key interest here is that Dixieland Band's second dam is by Warfare, who is by Determined out of a mare by War Glory. Alleged's second dam Determined Lady is by Determine out of a mare by War Glory's three-parts brother War Admiral, making Warfare and Determined Lady genetic relatives. Hoist the Flag himself adds to the mix, as he is out of a War Admiral mare. Determine may also play a part in Dixieland Band's combination with Graustark and His Maiestv. Determine is by Alibhai out of a mare by Mahmoud, and Flower Bowl (dam of Graustark and His Majesty) is by Alibhai out of a daughter of a Mahmoud mare.
