#### SADLER'S WELLS COLT TOPS HOUGHTON

SALE A seven-figure yearling led the way in a strong closing session of the Tattersalls' Houghton Yearling Sale in Newmarket, England last night. The colt, a son of Sadler's Wells--Crystal Spray (Beldale Flutter), from Lord and Lady Lloyd-Webber's Watership Down Stud, topped the session and the sale with a final bid of \$1,042,163 from Demi O'Byrne. Watership Down also sold the sale's second highest-priced colt, hip number 329, by Sadler's Wells--Darara (Top Ville), to Godolphin Management Co. for \$833,730. At last night's session, 73 yearlings sold for \$15,127,203, averaging \$207,220. The average was up 17.9 percent from last year's corresponding period, when 65 horses sold for a total of \$11,425,441 and an average of \$175,775. During the three-day sale, 302 horses sold for an aggregate of \$53,415,936 and an average of \$176,873. The average price is down 13.4 percent from last year's sale when 213 horses sold for a total of \$43,482,373 and an average of \$204,142. "After last year's record-breaking Houghton Yearling Sale, we always felt it would be a hard act to follow," admitted Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "But we are delighted that the sale has achieved a six-figure average for only the second time in European bloodstock sales history and that the all-important median figure has advanced to record levels with a significantly larger catalog." For the second time in four years, trainer David Morley put blinkers for the first time on an unfancied runner in this famous event and again the tactic worked perfectly, with Hayil pulling off a 14-1 surprise. Back in 1994, Morley scored with 33-1 longshot Fard. Always up with the strong pace, Hayil took command at the halfway point and was never seriously threatened. The G2 Gimcrack S. winner Carrowkeel (Ire) finished well for the place. Asked about the use of blinkers, Morley said: "Havil's a tough little horse and I've always thought he was genuine, but he sometimes lacks concentration in his races, so we tried the blinkers on him at home and he worked OK, so we decided to use them today. They just make him think more. He may only have won twice, but he's never run a bad race." Odds-on favorite ARKADIAN HERO (Trempolino) missed the break and never got to the leaders. His rider Frankie Dettori said: "This was a bit short for him. I had to rush him too early to try to get him into a challenging position." Bookmakers showed little reaction to Havil's win, leaving him at 25-1 in the English 2000 Guineas betting, which still has the unbeaten Daggers Drawn as 6-1 favorite.


